Comments: Establish an aggressive production credit for Generation Partners based on efficiency of the building. Homes with a set energy star or HERS rating would receive higher production credits. For example a home using 30% less than the state average would receive 20 cents a kwh and a home using only half the state average (for a comparable size home) would receive 25 cents a kwh for solar generation. This encourages both energy efficiency and clean power generation.

With a goal of 50,000 homes participating the program could help offset other additional added capacity or reduce natural gas generator fuel expense
