1) I oppose net metering. while it does create an ofset for the consumer, it doesn't purport to be the most efficient method of generation - i.e. a customer could have an energy inefficient generating facility that actually serves to waste fuel or increase pollutants above the amount that TVA would be generating for compaprable power.

2) Smart Metering - I strongly support smart metering as it promotes variable rates for the potential time of day and time of week I might also add to be considered. This allows the consumer access to power and lets them elect what they wish to consume and at what cost. Similarly, there could be oportunities for TVA to price at significant discount off-peak hours (as 12am-5am). This is no different from a long distance phone carrier or mobile phone carrier, why not electricity too!
