Comments: LifeWay consumes an average of 3.1 megawatts per month and our payments are from one banking account - 13 meters. These 13 meters are fed from four different distributor vaults spaced around our 14 acre campus. I think current software technologies can agreegate the loads and create a single invoice per month. The Nashville Electric Service representatives tell me the TVA metering rules govern their billing procedures. I recommend the TVA metering rules be reviewed with an intent to maximize current software options to reduce thenumber of invoices mailed to a single owner.

I am in favor of smart metering as it allows businesses, and individuals, to elevate other technologies to achieve their mission. In our case thermal energy storage may have an acceptable ROI with time-based metering rates.
