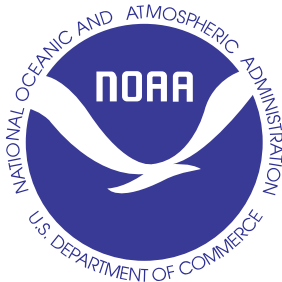

The National Weather Service will train new or veteran spotters, including interested citizens, amateur radio, CERT, neighborhood preparedness groups, law enforcement, fire/EMS, Emergency Management, etc. on **how to look for, recognize, and report significant weather events**. Training includes video demonstrations and instruction by NWS experts.
