#### What it's all about

If you are a technology-based company looking for employees, or someone with a technology background looking for employment opportunities, Pacific Northwest National Laboratory's (PNNL) Tech Job Connection could be for you.

Tech Job Connection is a web-based listing of resumes and job postings for individuals and firms in the Mid-Columbia area of eastern Washington. Employers post their positions; job seekers post their resumes. In some cases, they find each other right here on our site.

This free service was created by PNNL to help local technology-based businesses start and grow while promoting local economic diversification. PNNL's economic development efforts include helping technology-based businesses build effective and experienced management teams to move entrepreneurial ventures to the next level of growth and profitability.



# How does the Tech Job Connection work?

Employers and individuals looking for technology-based employment opportunities can post job openings and resumes on our website at <a href="http://www.pnl.gov/edo/resources/tjc/">http://www.pnl.gov/edo/resources/tjc/</a>. PNNL staff then review these submittals to ensure qualifications (see reverse side) are met. Anyone can view the jobs and resumes and contact the companies or individuals of interest.

If candidates or companies wish to remain anonymous, resumes and position descriptions can be listed on the website without contact information. PNNL will forward any inquires regarding the anonymous postings to the submitters.

# Are you eligible to post a job or resume on Tech Job Connection?

If you are a looking for **employment opportunities**, you must:

- be looking for a compensated position with a technology-based company, such as an executive, manager, engineer, technician, accountant, information technology professional, etc.
- be seeking a non-Hanford job
- be seeking work at a firm within a 50-mile radius of PNNL
- have completed at least one year of college.


If you are a company with **current job openings**, you must:

- be a technology-based organization, including such fields as manufacturing, information technology, biotech, medical, electronics, energy, etc.
- have a job opening that is technical or managerial in nature, such as an executive, manager, engineer, technician, etc.
- not primarily be a Hanford contractor
- be located within a 50-mile radius of PNNL.

# Service Providers on Tech Job Connection

In addition to posting jobs and resumes on Tech Job Connection, regional service providers can also post listings. If a company is not in a position to hire a new employee, but may require help on a project, professional services, or need to fill a position on a temporary basis, it can search the Service Providers list.
