DECISIONS IN ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

BERNARD ZIPERN BARRED

U.S. SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION

The Commission has ordered that Bernard Zipern be barred from association with any broker-dealer, investment company or investment adviser. The sanction was based on findings that Zipern, secretary-treasurer, shareholder and director of S.J. Salmon & Co., Inc. (registrant), a registered broker-dealer, (1) wilfully violated and wilfully aided and abetted violations of Sections 5 and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Sections 7(c)(1), 10(b), 15(c)(1), 15(c)(2) and 15(c)(3) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 10b-5, 10b-6, 15cl-3, 15c2-4 and 15c3-1, and Regulation T promulgated thereunder, (2) wilfully aided and abetted violations of Sections 15(b) and 17(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 15b3-1, 17a-3 and 17a-4 promulgated thereunder, and (3) that on February 7, 1972, a trustee was appointed for the registrant pursuant to the Securities Investor Protection Act of 1970 at a time when Zipern was associated with the registrant as an officer, director and share-holder.

Zipern consented to the entry of said findings and order without admitting or denying the allegations contained therein. The sanction is effective on the second Monday following the date of the order. (Rel. 34-12679)

TRADING SUSPENSIONS

TRADING SUSPENDED IN FREMONT CORP.
AND BLACKSTONE INTERNATIONAL CORP.

The SEC has announced the single ten-day suspension of exchange and over-the-counter trading in the securities of Fremont Corp. (Fremont), a Colorado corporation located in New York, and Blackstone International Corp. (Blackstone), a Utah corporation located in Deer Park, New York, for the period beginning at 10:00 a.m. on August 13 and terminating at midnight (EDT) on August 22, 1976. The Commission ordered the suspension of Fremont and Blackstone because of the lack of adequate and accurate public information regarding each company's operations and financial condition.
