CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

MEDISCIENCE TECHNOLOGY CORPORATION ENJOINED

The Commission announced that on January 30 the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia enjoined Mediscience Technology Corporation of Moorestown, New Jersey, from failing to timely file periodic reports with the Commission and ordered it to comply with certain undertakings.

The Commission's complaint, filed on December 23, 1980, alleged that Mediscience failed to file certain annual and quarterly reports as part of a continuing course of conduct. Mediscience, in consented to entry of judgment against it, admitted failure to file reports on seven separate occasions. (SEC v. Mediscience Technology Corporation, U.S.D.C. KREDIETBANK N.V.
