# HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

AMERICAN EXPRESS COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 3 to request a hearing on an application by American Express Company, a New York corporation principally engaged in providing travel-related, financial, international banking, information and investment services. The application is for an order declaring that it is not a "holding company" under Section 2(a)(7) of the Act by virtue of its ownership of auction preferred stock, no par value, of Tucson Electric Power Company, an electric utility company. The stock, which has voting rights as of December 14, 1991, currently represents approximately 11% of the outstanding voting securities of Tucson Electric. (Rel. 35-25452)

### INDIANA MICHIGAN POWER COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 3 to request a hearing on a proposal by Indiana Michigan Power Company (Indiana Michigan), an electric public-utility subsidiary company of American Electric Power Company, Inc., a registered holding company. Indiana Michigan proposes to alter the terms of the purchase of certain emission control facilities, as those terms are affected by the sale of an additional series of pollution control revenue bonds to be issued by the City of Lawrenceburg, Indiana (City), through December 31, 1992, pursuant to an agreement that Indiana Michigan has with the City. # SYSTEM FUELS, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 3 to request a hearing on a proposal by System Fuels, Inc. (SFI), a fuel procurement company, and two of its parent companies, Louisiana Power & Light Company and Arkansas Power & Light Company, each an electric public-utility subsidiary company of Entergy Corporation (Entergy), a registered holding company. The proposal was also made by System Energy Resources, Inc., also an electric public-utility subsidiary of Entergy. SFI proposes to amend a credit agreement between SFI and The Yasuda Trust and Banking Co., Ltd., New York Branch, as agent for a group of lenders, in order to extend such credit agreement's expiration date through September 30, 1994 and increase the commitment fee. ### NORTHEAST UTILITIES, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 3 to request a hearing on a proposal by Northeast Utilities (Northeast), a registered holding company, and its subsidiary companies, Western Massachusetts Electric Company, The Quinnehtuk Company, The Connecticut Light and Power Company, Northeast Utilities Service Company, Northeast Nuclear Energy Company, The Rocky River Realty Company and Holyoke Water Power Company, and Public Service Company of New Hampshire (PSNH) and North Atlantic Energy Corporation (North Atlantic), both companies authorized to become subsidiaries of Northeast (HCAR Nos. 25221 and 25273, December 21, 1990 and March 15, 1991, respectively) (all companies collectively, Applicants). The Applicants propose to add PSNH and North Atlantic, through December 31, 1992, as participants in the Northeast system money pool (Money Pool). PSNH's and North Atlantic's borrowings from the Money Pool will not exceed \$125 million and \$65 million, respectively. (Rel. 35-25452)

#### PENNSYLVANIA ELECTRIC COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 3 to request a hearing on a proposal by Pennsylvania Electric Company, a public-utility subsidiary company of General Public Utilities Corporation, a registered holding company, to sell certain utility assets to Pennsylvania State University for \$219,581. # NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY, ET AL.

The application is for an order declaring that it is not a "holding company" under Section 2(a)(7) of the Act by virtue of its ownership of auction preferred stock, no par value, of Tucson Electric Power Company, an electric-utility company. The stock, which has voting rights as of December 14, 1991, currently represents more than 10% of the outstanding preferred stock of Tucson Electric, but less than 10% of all of the outstanding voting securities of Tucson Electric, including common stock.
