INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES EXCHANGE SECTION

PILGRIM CORPORATE CASH FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 18 to request a hearing on an application filed by Pilgrim Corporate Cash Fund for an order pursuant to Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18489 - January 22)

EQUUS INVESTMENTS II, L.P. ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 17 to request a hearing on an application filed by Equus Investments II, L.P. (Partnership), Equus II Incorporated (Fund), Equus Capital Corporation and Equus Capital Management Corporation. The application is for an order under Section 57(c) of the Investment Company Act granting an exemption from Section 57(a) of the Act. The exemption would allow for a reorganization under which the Partnership will transfer all of its assets, including all securities and cash (subject to liabilities), to the Fund in exchange for Fund shares having an aggregate net asset value equal to the value of the net assets of the Partnership. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MISSISSIPPI POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Mississippi Power Company (Mississippi), an electric utility subsidiary company of The Southern Company, a registered holding company, to acquire 8.97% of the common stock of WFI Industries Limited (WF-Canada), a publicly held Canadian company. In connection with the acquisition, Mississippi will grant WF-Canada a license to manufacture and distribute products using Mississippi's patented heat pump technology. (Rel. 35-25457)

THE CONNECTICUT LIGHT & POWER CO., ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by The Connecticut Light & Power Company and Western Massachusetts Electric Company (Applicants), each a public-utility subsidiary company of Northeast Utilities, a registered holding company. The Applicants propose to replace an existing credit facility for financing the acquisition of nuclear fuel with a new \$230 million revolving credit facility (Facility) with a syndicate of banks, with The First National Bank of Chicago serving

as agent. The Applicants also propose to continue their authorization through December 31, 1998 to make borrowings under the Facility and to issue intermediate term notes of up to \$300 million. In addition, the Applicants propose to sell commercial paper notes (Commercial Paper) under an exception from competitive bidding which, together with borrowings under the Facility, would not exceed \$230 million aggregate principal amount outstanding at any one time. Finally, the Applicants propose to amend certain existing agreements regarding nuclear leasing, security and assignment of contracts. (Rel. 35-25458)

LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES SOUGHT

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until February 11 to comment on the applications of four exchanges for unlisted trading privileges in issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchanges and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. The exchanges and number of issues are as follows: Philadelphia Stock Exchange - 7 issues (Rel. 34-30264); Cincinnati Stock Exchange - 32 issues (Rel. 34-30271); Pacific Stock Exchange - 8 issues (Rel. 34-30272); and Midwest Stock Exchange - 8 issues (Rel. 34-30273).

UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES GRANTED

Orders have been issued granting the applications of three exchanges for unlisted trading privileges in issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchanges and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. The exchanges and number of issues are as follows: Pacific Stock Exchange - 1 issue (Rel. 34-30274); Philadelphia Stock Exchange - 25 issues (Rel. 34-30275); and Midwest Stock Exchange - 1 issue (Rel. 34-30276).

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-91-65) under Rule 19b-4 to amend Parts II and III of Schedule C to the NASD By-Laws to permit Direct Participation Program (DPP) Principals and Representatives to offer and sell direct participation program debt. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of January 27. (Rel. 34-30279)

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-91-62) under Rule 19b-4 to amend the Interpretation of the Board of Governors - Review of Corporate Financing, Article III, Section 1 of the NASD's Rules of Fair Practice. The purpose of the rule change is to exempt from the filing requirements of the Corporate Financing Interpretation those offerings made on SEC Forms F-3, F-9 and F-10. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of January 27. (Rel. 34-30281)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted under Rule 19b-4 by the New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-91-38) to add NYSE Rules 704, 705, 780.10(b), 80A(c) and (d), and 116.30 to the List of Exchange Rule Violations and Fines under Rule 476A. The Commission also approved the NYSE's proposal to amend its minor rule violation enforcement and reporting plan to include the above-named rules. (Rel. 34-30280)

SIGNIFICANT NO-ACTION AND INTERPRETATIVE LETTERS
