#### COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

#### CHIEF ACCOUNTANT TO TESTIFY

Walter P. Schuetze, Chief Accountant of the Commission, will testify before the Subcommittee on Oversight of Government Management of the Senate Committee on Governmental Affairs. The hearing is scheduled for Friday, January 31, at 9:00 a.m., in Room 342 of the Dirksen Senate Office Building. The subject matter is accounting for employee stock compensation.

#### ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS ON APPLICATION BY FIRST POTOMAC INVESTMENT SERVICES REMANDED TO NASD

The Commission has remanded to the NASD an appeal by First Potomac Investment Services, Inc., a Falls Church, Virginia brokerage firm. First Potomac seeks relief from an NASD-imposed restriction on its membership that prohibits it from trading uncovered options. It asked the NASD for a modification of that restriction that would allow it to trade uncovered equity puts under specified margin and equity requirements and position limits. The NASD denied that request and First Potomac appealed to the Commission.

The Commission found that, in denying First Potomac's request, the NASD had "failed to address the specific conditions upon which the firm [had] based its [proposal]," thereby preventing the Commission from properly exercising its review function. The Commission accordingly remanded the matter to the NASD for further consideration of First Potomac's request. Without expressing any view as to the proper outcome of the matter, the Commission stated that, if the NASD once again denies First Potomac's request, it must "set forth its overriding concerns and explain with some particularity how they outweigh the merits of First Potomac's proposal." #### INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

BOSTON CAPITAL TAX CREDIT FUND III L.P. BOSTON CAPITAL ASSOCIATES III L.P.

> An order has been issued on an application filed by Boston Capital Tax Credit Fund III L.P., a limited partnership (Partnership), and its general partner, Boston Capital Associates III L.P., under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting the Partnership from all provisions of the Act. The Partnership will operate as a "twotier" limited partnership by investing in other limited partnerships that, in turn, will engage in the development, ownership and operation of housing for low and moderate income persons. (Rel. IC-18501 - January 24)

ZWEIG SERIES TRUST, ET AL.

A conditional order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Zweig Series Trust, et al., from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 18(f), 18(g), 18(i), 22(c), and 22(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder. The order permits certain open-end investment companies to (a) issue and sell separate

classes of shares representing interests in the same investment portfolio, and (b) assess a contingent deferred sales load on certain redemptions of shares of one of the classes. (Rel. IC-18502 - January 28)

#### VANCE SANDERS SPECIAL FUND

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that Vance Sanders Special Fund has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18503 - January 28)

PRUDENTIAL-BACHE SHORT-TERM GLOBAL INCOME FUND, INC. (D/B/A PRUDENTIAL SHORT TERM GLOBAL INCOME FUND), ET AL.

A second notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 24, 1992 to request a hearing on an application filed by Prudential-Bache Short-Term Global Income Fund, Inc. (d/b/a Prudential Short-Term Global Income Fund), et al., for an exemption under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act from the provisions of Sections 18(f), 18(g) and 18(i). The applicants seek an order that would permit them to sell two classes of securities and implement a conversion feature for the purpose of establishing an alternative purchase and conversion plan. PROVIDENTMUTUAL LIFE AND ANNUITY COMPANY OF AMERICA, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act (the Act) exempting Providentmutual Life and Annuity Company of America, Providentmutual Variable Annuity Separate Account (the Account) and PML Securities Company from Sections 26(a)(2) and 27(c)(2) of the Act to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges from the assets of the Account under certain variable annuity contracts. #### HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

LES DEVELOPPEMENTS HYDROELECTRIQUES CHI, INC. CONSOLIDATED HYDRO, INC.

An order has been issued extending until December 31, 1992 the time in which Consolidated Hydro, Inc., and its wholly-owned subsidiary, Les Developpements Hydroelectriques CHI, Inc., may carry out certain transactions related to an order of exemption under Section 3(a)(5) of the Act (Holding Company Act Release No. 25393, October 16, 1991). NORTHEAST UTILITIES, ET AL.

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A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Northeast Utilities (NU), a registered holding company, and Charter Oak Energy, Inc., a non-utility subsidiary company of NU, to undertake certain preliminary development activities with respect to independent power production projects. ## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

#### IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-91-49) filed by the <u>Chicago Board Options Exchange</u> under Rule 19b-4 which extends until March 31, 1992, a pilot program that provides a 50% rebate on transaction and trade match fees for "box" trades by public customers in Standard & Poor's 500 Stock Index options, provided the "box trade totals 500 or more contracts for the four sides of the trade, has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the order is expected to appear in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of January 27. (Rel. 34-30288)

#### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission has approved a proposed rule change filed under Rule 19b-4 by the <u>New</u> <u>York Stock Exchange</u> (SR-NYSE-91-36) to provide for electronic "T+1" overnight comparison of Exchange option transactions to be implemented gradually beginning on January 27, 1992, and to be completed by March 31, 1992. Publication of the approval order is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of January 27. (Rel. 34-30293)

The Commission has approved a proposed rule change filed under Rule 19b-4 by the <u>Participants Trust Company</u> (SR-PTC-90-02) to enable PTC to operate a back-up processing facility in case of an environmental disaster that would prevent PTC from operating out of its primary New York facility. Publication of the proposed rule change is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of February 3. (Rel. 34-30296)

#### PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> has filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-91-66) under Rule 19b-4 which would codify into NASD's Uniform Practice Code certain existing policies relating to "when, as and if issued" and "when, as and if distributed" securities contracts. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of January 27. (Rel. 34-30295)

The <u>Options Clearing Corporation</u> has filed a proposed rule change (SR-OCC-92-01) that would revise the Canadian Clearing Fund Depository Receipt and Security Agreement and the Canadian Margin Depository Receipt and Security Agreement (Agreements) to provide for transmission of the Agreements by electronic means. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of February 3. (Rel. 34-30297; International Series Release No. 362)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the <u>Boston Stock Exchange</u> (SR-BSE-91-07) to add  $\P2261$  to Chapter XXVII of its rules in order to provide listing guidelines for hybrid securities products. (Rel. 34-30294)

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
