U.S. SECURITIES

CHARGE COMMUNICION

CHAIRMAN BREEDEN TO TESTIFY

Chairman Breeden is scheduled to testify before the Committee on Banking, Finance and Urban Affairs and the Subcommittee on Domestic Monetary Policy on Thursday, February 6, at 10:00 a.m. The hearing will be held in Room 2128 of the Rayburn House Office Building. The subject matter is concerning the joint report on the government securities market.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

FORMER SALESPERSON NAMED IN PROCEEDINGS

The Commission announced that on January 29 public administrative proceedings were instituted against Molly C. Wilson, a securities salesperson formerly associated with Cowles Sabol & Co. The proceedings were based on a criminal conviction and on an injunction entered against Wilson in [SEC v. Molly C. Wilson, C91-1146(Z)C] in the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Washington where it was alleged that Wilson misappropriated more than \$400,000 from her customers. The Commission's complaint alleged that Wilson failed to disclose that she intended to misappropriate customer funds intended for the purchase of securities and that the purported securities she offered and sold did not exist. The complaint also alleged that there were risks involved in investment through her as a securities salesperson and, as to later investors, that she was no longer licensed to sell securities in the State of Washington. A hearing will be scheduled to determine what, if any, remedial action is appropriate in the public interest. (Rel. 34-30300)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST BRUCE NEWBERG

The Commission instituted administrative proceedings pursuant to Section 15(b)(6) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Bruce L. Newberg, formerly associated with Drexel Burnham Lambert, Inc., a broker-dealer registered with the Commission during all relevant times. The proceedings have been instituted to determine what remedial action, if any, should be taken as a result of Newberg's criminal conviction on November 6, 1989 in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York on two counts of securities fraud in violation of Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act, and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, for acts that occurred while he was associated with Drexel [U.S. v. James Sutton Regan, et al., S 88 Cr. 517, RLC]. By decision dated June 28, 1991, the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit affirmed Newberg's securities fraud convictions [U.S. v. James Sutton Regan, et al., Docket Nos. 89-1591, 1592, 1600, 1601, 1602 and 1614].

A hearing will be scheduled to take evidence of the staff's allegations and to afford the respondent an opportunity to present any defense. (Rel. 34-30301)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST CHARLES ZARZECKI

The Commission instituted administrative proceedings pursuant to Section 15(b)(6) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Charles M. Zarzecki, formerly associated with Princeton/Newport Partners, L.P., and Oakley Sutton Investment Corporation (OSIC), a broker-dealer registered with the Commission from December 1979 through October 1989. The proceedings have been instituted to determine what remedial action, if any, should be taken as a result of Zarzecki's criminal conviction on November 6, 1989 in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York on two counts of securities fraud in violation of Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act, and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, for acts that occurred while he was associated with OSIC [U.S. v. James Sutton Regan, et al., S 88 Cr. 517, RLC]. By decision dated June 28, 1991, the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit affirmed Zarzecki's securities fraud convictions [U.S. v. James Sutton Regan, et al., Docket Nos. 89-1591, 1592, 1600, 1601, 1602 and 1614].

A hearing will be scheduled to take evidence of the staff's allegations and to afford the respondent an opportunity to present any defense. (Rel. 34-30302)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CURRENT FINANCIAL SERVICES, INC., PUT INTO RECEIVERSHIP

The Commission announced that on February 3 the Honorable Stanley S. Harris, U.S. District Judge for the District of Columbia, granted the Commission's motion to appoint a receiver for Current Financial Services, Inc., in [SEC v. Current Financial Services, Inc., et al., 91-3089, SSH, D.D.C.]. The Court also denied Current's motion to modify the Temporary Restraining Order and Order for the Preservation of Assets and Other Relief (TRO). Current had requested that the Court allow it to resume its principal business of factoring accounts receivable, make interest payments to investors and pay certain expenses incurred prior to the entry of the TRO. See Litigation Release No. 13157 (February 4, 1992).

The Commission's complaint, filed on December 2, 1991, alleges that Current and sixteen other defendants engaged in a scheme to offer and sell debt securities in violation of Sections 5(a) and (c) and 17(a) of the Securities Act and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. On December 5, 1991, the Court entered the TRO against Current and six other defendants upon their consent. The Court entered a separate Temporary Restraining Order and Order for the Freezing of Assets and Other Relief against the other defendants. See Litigation Release No. 13112 (December 9, 1991). [SEC v. Current Financial Services, Inc., et al., Civ. Action No. 91-3089, SSH, D.D.C.] (LR-13157)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

EATON VANCE CASH MANAGEMENT FUND, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 25 to request a hearing on an application filed by Eaton Vance Cash Management Fund, et al. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act. The order would grant an exemption from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c) and 22(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder. The requested relief would permit each applicant to impose and, under certain circumstances, waive a contingent deferred sales load on certain redemptions of its shares. (Rel. IC-18516 - January 31)

VIKING EQUITY INDEX FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 28 to request a hearing on an application filed by Viking Equity Index Fund, Inc. for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that applicant has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18517 - February 3)

CASH MANAGEMENT FUND, ET AL.

A conditional order has been issued under Section 17(b) of the Investment Company Act exempting Cash Management Fund, et al. from the provisions of Section 17(a) to permit certain reorganizations. (Rel. IC-18518 - February 4)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the <u>Pacific Stock Exchange</u> (SR-PSE-91-36) to amend its rules to require submission of a \$500 filing fee with a petition for review of a disciplinary decision to the Exchange pursuant to Rule 10.8. (Rel. 34-30309)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change has been filed under Rule 19b-4 by the <u>Chicago Board Options Exchange</u> (SR-CBOE-91-51) to list and trade options on the CBOE Biotech Index. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of February 3. (Rel. 34-30324)

A proposed rule change has been filed under Rule 19b-4 by <u>The Options Clearing Corporation</u> (SR-OCC-92-4) to alphabetize the definitions sections of OCC's By-Laws and Rules. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of February 3. (Rel. 34-30327)

A proposed rule change has been filed under Rule 19b-4 by <u>The Options Clearing Corporation</u> (SR-OCC-92-2) to add a public director category to its board of directors. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of February 3. (Rel. 34-30328)

A proposed rule change has been filed under Rule 19b-4 by the <u>Chicago Board Options</u> <u>Exchange</u> (SR-CBOE-92-02) to allow the CBOE to list for trading options on the Russell 2000 Index (Russell 2000). The Russell 2000 is a market-weighted index composed of the bottom 2000 of the 3000 largest U.S. equity securities in terms of domestic market capitalization. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of February 3. (Rel. 34-30329)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL ON A TEMPORARY BASIS OF A PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval on a temporary basis of a proposed rule change submitted by the <u>Midwest Securities Trust Company</u> (SR-MSTC-92-01) relating to the establishment of the Institutional Participant Services Program. Publication of the order is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of February 3. (Rel. 34-30326)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the American Stock Exchange (SR-Amex-91-32) to permit the trading of LT-20 Index options on the Optiebeurs N.V. (European Options Exchange or EOE) under the same terms and conditions which currently apply to Major Market Index options trading on the EOE. Publication of the order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 3. (Rel. 34-30331)

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change submitted by The Options Clearing Corporation (SR-OCC-92-03) to authorize OCC to clear and settle options on the LT-20 Index that are traded on the European Options Exchange. Publication of the order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 3. (Rel. 34-30333)
