ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST RAPHEL BLOOM AND ALAN SCOP

The Commission announced that it has instituted public administrative proceedings pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Raphael Bloom and Alan Scop.

The Order Instituting Public Administrative Proceedings alleges that on November 8, 1989 Bloom and Scop were each found guilty of one count of conspiracy and six counts of securities fraud and that Bloom was additionally found guilty of six counts of mail fraud and one count of perjury before a federal grand jury in Chicago in connection with a scheme to manipulate the price of European Auto Classics, Ltd. stock during the period from 1979 to May 1982. The Order also alleges that Bloom was convicted of one count of perjury before a federal grand jury in New York in connection with the same scheme. In addition, the Order alleges that Scop was permanently enjoined in a separate civil action from further violations of the securities registration and antifraud statutes.

A hearing will be scheduled to determine what, if any, remedial action would b_e appropriate with respect to Bloom and/or Scop. (Rel. 34-30372)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MONY LEGACY VARIABLE ACCOUNT L

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that MONY Legacy Variable Account L has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel IC-18560 - February 20)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>Depository Trust Company</u> filed a proposed rule change to establish a revised schedule of its fees that would be effective for services performed after February 29, 1992. The proposed rule change became effective immediately upon filing with the Commission. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of February 24. (Rel. 34-30381)

ACQUISITION OF SECURITIES

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
