COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

SECTION 16 LETTER INDEX BY SUBJECT MATTER

The Division of Corporation Finance has released an index organizing by subject matter Section 16 letters issued through March 1, 1992. ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

FRANK ROLLINS MAXWELL BARRED

The Commission announced that on February 24 administrative proceedings were instituted pursuant to Section 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 against Frank Rollins Maxwell, a principal of American Foresight, Inc. (Adviser), a registered investment adviser. Simultaneously with the institution of the proceedings, the Commission accepted Maxwell's Offer of Settlement wherein he consented to the entry of an order finding that he had been permanently enjoined from aiding and abetting violations of the antifraud and recordkeeping provisions of the Advisers Act (SEC v. American Foresight, Inc., Thomas F. Heffernan, and Frank Rollins Maxwell, 91 Civ. 5382, PNL, SDNY). The order bars Maxwell from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company or municipal securities dealer provided, however, that Maxwell has the right to apply to become so associated three years after the entry of the order.

The underlying complaint alleged that Maxwell aided and abetted the misappropriation of over \$90,000 of client funds by the Adviser and its principal, Thomas F. Heffernan. Instead of investing these funds in securities, the complaint alleged that these funds were illegally used to pay the operating expenses of the Adviser and Heffernan's personal expenses. (Rel. JOSEPH HURTON BARRED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against Joseph Hurton, a former registered representative for a broker-dealer registered with the Commission under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 based upon the

entry of an Order of Permanent Injunction against Hurton in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Ohio, his underlying violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws and his criminal conviction on three counts of felony theft. Simultaneously, Hurton submitted an offer of settlement which the Commission accepted. Accordingly, the Commission entered an Order Instituting Public Proceedings, Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions which finds, among other things, that Hurton falsely represented to investors that their funds would be invested in securities. However, these funds were not invested as described but were instead misappropriated by respondent. Further, Hurton misrepresented to investors the rates of return to be obtained on investments and omitted to disclose the risks involved in investing with him. The Commission barred Hurton from association with any broker dealer, investment adviser, investment company or municipal securities dealer. (Rel. 34-30397)

DECISION BARRING ROGER HOUDEK FINAL

The decision of an administrative law judge barring Roger J. Houdek of Englewood, Colorado from association with any broker or dealer has become final. After one year Houdek may become employed by a registered broker-dealer in a non-proprietary, nonsupervisory position as a registered representative restricted to transactions in mutual fund shares and variable annuities.

Houdek was vice president, secretary and a 20% shareholder of Colorado Planning Associates, Inc. (Planning). During the period from about July 1982 to November 1984 he violated registration and antifraud provisions in selling limited partnership interests for Planning to investors. Houdek used pre-existing relationships of trust and confidence with former insurance clients to switch them from conservative retirement annuities to highly speculative partnership interests. Commissions and fees were obtained from investors' funds without full disclosure, partnership funds were commingled and the partnerships' financial stability and future earning prospects were misrepresented. Houdek also misrepresented his experience and understanding of these offerings and their tax consequences. He did not disclose the fact that, in two offerings, the partnerships had defaulted on mortgage payments. In November 1984, Houdek committed further violations in connection with the sale of limited partnership interests by his own firm, Strategic Investments, Inc.

Houdek also aided and abetted Planning's failure to register as a broker-dealer. In April 1991, he was enjoined on the basis of the foregoing violations.

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has approved a proposed rule change (SR-Phlx-91-06) filed by the <u>Philadelphia Stock Exchange</u> which awards "applicant" status to prospective members, granting them unescorted access to the Exchange trading floor for a period of twentyone business days. Publication of the approval order is expected in the <u>Federal</u> <u>Register</u> during the week of March 2. (Rel. 34-30416)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change (SR-Amex-92-07) filed by the <u>American Stock Exchange</u> clarifying the requirements of a spread position to be included in the Amex's debit put spread pilot program has become effective upon filing with the Commission. Specifically, the proposal clarifies that the strike price of the long leg of a spread must exceed the strike price of the long leg of a spread must exceed the strike price of the short leg in order for the spread to be eligible for the pilot program. Publication of the notice is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of March 2. (Rel. 34-30419)
