U.S. SECURITIES EXCHANGE COMMISSION

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

COMMISSION ACCEPTS OFFER OF SETTLEMENT BY THOMAS WHITE & CO., INC.

The Commission announced today the acceptance of an Offer of Settlement submitted by Thomas F. White & Co., Inc. (White & Co.) in the administrative proceeding instituted by the Commission on September 27, 1991. By its Offer, White & Co. consented to the entry of an Order by the Commission censuring White & Co., and requiring it to comply with its undertakings to retain an independent Special Review Person to review White & Co.'s existing policies and procedures related to each and every aspect of its activities, take all necessary and appropriate steps to implement all recommendations made by the Special Review Person, and not conduct business as a self-clearing firm for a period of three years from the date of the entry of the Order. White & Co., consented to the findings and the imposition of sanctions without admitting or denying the findings. (Rel. 34-30471)

STEPHEN HALEY BARRED

The Commission announced that it issued an Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions against Stephen T. Haley (Haley) in a public administrative proceeding previously instituted against him. Based on Haley's Offer of Settlement, the Commission found that Haley engaged in a scheme to fraudulently register the securities of Novaferon Labs, Inc. and to fraudulently promote the activities of the company subsequent to registration. The Commission also found that Haley was permanently enjoined by default from further violations or aiding and abetting violations of the antifraud, registration, periodic reporting, securities ownership reporting and books and record keeping provisions of the federal securities laws (See, SEC v. Novaferon Labs, Inc., et al., Civil No. 5:90 CV1446, USDC, ND/Ohio, December 14, 1990). The Commission also found that Haley willfully violated or aided and abetted violations of those same provisions.

Also based on Haley's Offer, the Commission barred Haley from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company. Haley is currently serving an 83-year prison sentence for a related criminal conviction (See, Rel. 34-29659). (Rel. 34-30472)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

GARY BLATTER, BLAINE CHAMBERS AND RONALD WHEELER, SR. INDICTED

The Commission announced that on March 10 a Federal Grand Jury sitting in Nevada returned a five-count Indictment charging Gary Blatter, an Orem Utah attorney, Blaine Chambers, and Ronald Wheeler, Sr., the former owner of Stoneridge Securities, with conspiracy, securities fraud and wire fraud. Each of the defendants were charged with: conspiring to violate federal securities laws, violating Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5, and two counts of wire fraud. Blatter and Chambers were also charged with conspiring to obstruct the lawful functions of the Securities and Exchange Commission by filing a false registration statement on Form S-18. The prosecution involves sham initial "blind pool" public stock offerings and subsequent re-sale of those securities by Thomas Quinn through his European brokerage operations to unsuspecting victims in numerous countries throughout the world. [U.S. v. Gary Blatter, et al., CR-S-92-059-PMP, LRL, USDC, District of Nevada] (LR-13190)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

UNITED INVESTORS LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 13 to request a hearing on an application filed by United Investors Life Insurance Company (United Investors), United Investors Annuity Variable Account (Variable Account) and Waddell & Reed, Inc. (collectively, Applicants). The application is for an order of the Commission pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Applicants from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(35), 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act. The exemptions apply to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of a premium-based deferred sales load from the assets of the Variable Account under certain variable annuity contracts. (Rel. IC-18616 - March 17)

HILLIARD LYONS GROWTH FUND, INC.

A conditional order has been issued on an application filed by Hilliard Lyons Growth Fund, Inc. under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting the applicant from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c) and 22(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder. The conditional order permits the applicant to impose and, under certain circumstances, waive a contingent deferred sales load on certain redemptions of its shares. In addition, an erratum has been issued correcting the file number under which the notice of the application was published. (Rel. IC-18617 - March 18)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF OKLAHOMA

An order has been issued authorizing Public Service Company of Oklahoma, a public-utility subsidiary company of Central and South West Corporation, a registered holding company, to sell certain utility assets to St. John Medical Center for \$528,349. (Rel. 34-25491)

NORTHERN STATES POWER COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 11 to request a hearing on a proposal by Northern States Power Company, a public-utility holding company exempt from registration by order under Section 3(a)(2) of the Act, and its wholly owned nonutility subsidiary companies, The NRG Group and NRG Energy, Inc. The proposal seeks to acquire, through a wholly owned Netherlands subsidiary, up to a one-third ownership interest in a Portuguese electric-utility subsidiary company, Superpego. Superpego will be formed to acquire the assets of an electric generating station currently under construction in Portugal. The applicants request an order approving the proposed acquisition under Sections 9(a)(2) and 10, granting Superpego an unqualified order of exemption under Section 3(b) and granting certain intermediate holding companies an order of exemption under Section 3(a)(5). GENERAL PUBLIC UTILITIES CORPORATION, ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by General Public Utilities Corporation (GPU), a registered holding company, and its wholly owned subsidiary companies, Jersey Central Power & Light Company (JCP&L), Metropolitan Edison Company (Met-Ed), and Pennsylvania Electric Company (Penelec) (collectively, GPU Companies). The GPU Companies are authorized through March 31, 1995 to issue, sell and renew unsecured promissory notes in amounts up to \$150 million at any one time outstanding and maturing not more than six months from the date of issue to certain banks under the terms of a revolving credit agreement. The GPU Companies are also authorized through March 31, 1995 to issue, sell and renew their unsecured promissory notes pursuant to loan participation arrangements and informal lines of credit in amounts up to the limitations on short-term indebtedness contained in their respective charters and, in the case of GPU, \$200 million. In addition, the GPU Companies are authorized through March 31, 1995 incur other short-term unsecured debt, from time to time, in amounts up to the limits permitted by their respective charters and, in the case of GPU, \$200 million. Further, the GPU Companies are authorized through March 31, 1995 in the case of JCP&L, Met-Ed and Penelec, issue and sell their respective unsecured promissory notes as commercial paper in amounts up to their respective charter limits. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-92-02) to extend for one year the NYSE's pilot program regarding stopping stock in minimum variation markets. (Rel. 34-30482)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>Boston Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-BSE-92-02) to adopt Section 7 of Chapter XXXIII to establish liability with respect to orders entered into the BEACON system. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of March 23. (Rel. 34-30487)

The Options Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-OCC-92-05) relating to options exercise settlement agreements with stock clearing corporations. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of March 23. (Rel. 34-30488)

The <u>National Securities Clearing Corporation</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-NSCC-91-07) relating to a revised options exercise settlement agreement and revised clearing fund formula. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of March 23. (Rel. 34-30489)

The <u>Stock Clearing Corporation of Philadelphia</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-SCCP-92-01) relating to a revised options exercise settlement agreement. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of March 23. (Rel. 34-30490)

The <u>Midwest Clearing Corporation</u> filed a proposed rule change relating to MCC's participants fund formula and trade guarantee policy as they relate to options exercises and assignments. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of March 23. (Rel. 34-30491)
