COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

U.S. SECURITIES EXCHANGE COMMISSION

CHAIRMAN BREEDEN TO TESTIFY

Chairman Breeden will testify before the Senate Subcommittee on Securities on Thursday, March 26, at 9:30 a.m. The hearing will take place in Room 538 of the Dirksen Senate Office Building. The subject matter is the Small Business Incentive Act of 1992.

UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN SEC AND BAPAPAM SIGNED

Today the United States Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) and the Indonesian Capital Market Supervisory Agency (BAPEPAM) signed an Understanding Regarding the Provision of Technical Assistance for the Development of the Indonesian Securities Markets and Mutual Cooperation (Understanding). This is the first such Understanding with an emerging market nation in Asia. In the Understanding, the SEC and the BAPEPAM expressed their mutual intention to promote the development of sound securities markets and regulatory mechanisms, as well as the integration of the Indonesian securities system into a broader international framework. RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

CORRECTION TO FINAL RULE

The Commission adopted the multijurisdictional disclosure system for Canadian issuers on July 1, 1991. As published, the final regulations contain errors which may prove to be misleading and are in need of clarification. In this release, authority citations, rules and forms containing such errors are being corrected. (Rels. 33-6902A; 34-29354A; 39-2267A; IC-18210A; International Series Rel. 291A)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

LOUIS SALVATORE FOTI PLEADS GUILTY

The Commission and the U.S. Attorney for the District of Utah announced the guilty plea on March 12 of Louis Salvatore Foti (Foti) for fraud in the offer of the securities of New Minority Ventures, Inc. (New Minority). Foti is from New York, New York

The one-count information charges Foti with his plan to control the stock of New Minority and to manipulate its price. During his guilty plea, Foti admitted that he planned to sell a control position in the stock of New Minority to an undercover agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation for \$60,000.00. Foti admitted that he traveled to Salt Lake City, Utah, on March 1, 1990, for the purpose of consummating the sale and that he turned over in excess of five million shares of New Minority stock to the undercover agent. Foti further admitted his involvement in a plan to artificially and illegally manipulate the price of New Minority stock. Foti indicated that the public would have been unaware of the control of the New Minority stock and of the manipulation of its price. [U.S. v. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PRUDENTIAL-BACHE INCOMEVERTIBLE PLUS FUND, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 14 to request a hearing on an application filed by Prudential-Bache IncomeVertible Plus Fund, Inc., et al. for a conditional order under Sections 6(c) and 17(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 17d-1 thereunder. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MISSISSIPPI POWER COMPANY
