# SECTION 16 LETTER INDEX BY SUBJECT MATTER

The Division of Corporation Finance has released an index organizing by subject matter Section 16 letters issued through May 1, 1992. ## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

#### GENESIS INVESTMENT CORPORATION ORDERED TO CEASE AND DESIST

The Commission announced that on April 27 it entered an Order pursuant to Section 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) that Genesis Investment Corporation (Genesis) permanently cease and desist from committing or causing any violation of, or any future violation of, Section 16(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 16a-2 and 16a-3 promulgated thereunder. The Commission simultaneously accepted Genesis's Offer of Settlement. The Order alleges that since October 1986, Genesis, a Utah corporation, located in Salt Lake City, Utah, has owned more than ten percent of the common stock of Multivest Corporation (Multivest) and that since June 1, 1989, Genesis has owned more than ten percent of the stock of New Age Corporation (New Age). The Order finds that Genesis filed a Form 3 and twenty Forms 4 from one to 182 weeks late for its holdings and transactions in excess of \$612,000 in Multivest's securities and that between January 1989 and April 1991 Genesis filed a Form 3 and six Forms 4 from seven to sixty-eight weeks late for transactions in excess of \$535,000 in New Age's securities. #### CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

FORMER SALESMAN OF CALIFORNIA AND WASHINGTON BROKER-DEALERS ENJOINED FROM VIOLATING INDUSTRY BAR ORDER

The Commission announced that on February 24, 1992 the Honorable Barbara J. Rothstein enjoined Richard Dale Radcliffe of Seattle, Washington, formerly a securities salesman with Spokane, Washington and Los Angeles, California broker-dealers. The injunction was entered against Radcliffe with his consent in the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Washington. The Commission's complaint alleged that Radcliffe violated Article II Section 3(b) of the By-Laws of the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. (NASD) by associating with three different NASD member firms after he had been barred from being so associated after January 1990. The Commission also alleged that in order to obtain employment he signed under oath applications on Form U-4 with each of the three brokers for filing with the NASD. These applications each contained at least ten misrepresentations or omissions of material facts regarding his disciplinary history, past employment and bankruptcy. [SEC v. Richard Dale Radcliffe, Civil Action No. C-92-256, W.D. Wash] (LR-13230)

STEPHEN KLOS, S. ANTHONY LARSON AND JOHN NYE ENJOINED AND ORDERED TO PAY DISGORGEMENT

The Commission announced that on April 13, 1992 Judge Thomas S. Zilly of the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Washington permanently enjoined Stephen J. Klos, S. Anthony Larson and John M. Nye with their consent and without their admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's complaint.

Judge Zilly enjoined Klos, Larson and Nye from violating the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and enjoined Klos and Larson from violating, and Nye from aiding or abetting violations of, the registration provisions of the Securities Act of 1933. Klos was also enjoined from violating the broker-dealer registration provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Judge Zilly also ordered disgorgement of \$380,160.65 by Klos, \$391,000 by Larson, and \$20,000 by Nye, with prejudgment interest.

The Commission's complaint alleged that Klos and Larson, aided and abetted by Nye, offered and sold about \$3,427,000 of unregistered notes and bonds issued by Fortune Group, Ltd. and Fortune Income Fund, Inc. in a Ponzi scheme and that Klos failed to register as a broker-dealer. [SEC v. Stephen J. Klos, S. Anthony Larson and John M. Nye, Civil Action No. C91-1301, W.D. WA] (LR-13231)

## PENNY STOCK FIRM FOUND TO VIOLATE COLD CALL RULE

The Commission announced that on April 1, 1992 an order of partial summary judgment was entered by Judge Carolyn R. Dimmick against Kochcapital, Inc., a Bellevue, Washington brokerage firm and Russell G. Koch, its president, finding violations by Kochcapital of Section 15(c)(2) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 15c2-6 thereunder, the "cold call" rule. In granting the Commission's motion for partial summary judgment the Court found that Kochcapital sold three securities: Genesis Services, Inc., International Environmental Group, Inc. and Unifirst Corporation as nondesignated (exempt) securities and that the firm failed to follow the rule's necessary procedures. Trial is scheduled for June 2, 1992. [SEC v. Kochcapital, Inc., et al., C91-547D, W.D. WA] (LR-13232)

### ELIZABETH MORGAN AND MICHAEL MCLOUGHLIN ENJOINED

The Commission announced that on February 5, 1992 the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Washington entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction by Default against Elizabeth Anne Morgan and Michael McLoughlin enjoining them from further violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. Morgan and McLoughlin were also ordered to disgorge \$3,501,811, plus prejudgment interest of \$563,401. Morgan and McLoughlin are residents of Vancouver, British Columbia.

The Court found that Morgan and McLoughlin defrauded United States investors by soliciting, and by causing others to solicit, investments in certain Canadian securities without intending to deliver such securities. and that salespersons made numerous fraudulent claims in the course of solicitations. Morgan and McLoughlin also defrauded United States investors in that potential investors were solicited initially by letters signed by Morgan who also participated in all aspects of Growth's fraudulent operations. Further, Morgan and McLoughlin defrauded United States investors in that McLoughlin solicited investments directly as a salesperson using the fictitious name Keith Gregory and that McLoughlin, as Growth's sales manager, caused others to solicit investments. [SEC v. Growth Capital Securities, Inc., et al., C90-387, W.D. WA] (LR-13233)

#### INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PACIFIC HORIZON FUNDS, INC. AND DOUGLAS FLETCHER

A conditional order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Douglas B. Fletcher, a member of the board of directors of Pacific Horizon Funds, Inc. (Company), from the definition of "interested person" set forth in Section 2(a)(19)(B)(ii) of the Act. The exemption is solely for the purpose of determining whether under Section 15(f) of the Act 75% of the members of the board of directors of the Company are not "interested persons" of its predecessor or successor investment adviser. (Rel. IC-18677 - April 27)

MATHERS AND COMPANY, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 22 to request a hearing on an application filed by Mathers and Company, Inc. (Adviser) and Mathers Fund, Inc. (Fund) for an order under Section 6(c) of the Act. The order would exempt the Adviser and the Fund from Section 15(a) of the Act so that certain repurchases by the Adviser of its common stock will not result in a termination of the investment advisory agreement between the Adviser and the Fund, requiring re-approval of the agreement by Fund shareholders under Section 15(a) of the Act. (Rel. IC-18678 - April 28)

GATEWAY TAX CREDIT FUND III LTD.
RJ CREDIT PARTNERS, INC.

An order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Gateway Tax Credit Fund III Ltd., a limited partnership (Partnership), from all provisions of the Act. The order permits the Partnership to invest in limited partnerships that engage in the development, ownership and operation of housing for low and moderate income persons. (Rel. IC-18679 - April 28)

EFC SPONSORS CORPORATION SYSTEMATIC AND SINGLE PAYMENT INVESTMENT PLANS FOR THE ACCUMULATION OF SHARES OF AXEHOUGHTON FUND B, INC.

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that EFC Sponsors Corporation Systematic and Single Payment Investment Plans for the Accumulation of Shares of Axe-Houghton Fund B, Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18680 - April 28)

EFC SPONSORS CORPORATION SYSTEMATIC AND SINGLE PAYMENT INVESTMENT PLANS FOR THE ACCUMULATION OF SHARES OF FUND OF AMERICA, INC.

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that EFC Sponsors Corporation Systematic and Single Payment Investment Plans for the Accumulation of Shares of Fund of America, Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18681 - April 28)

EFC SPONSORS CORPORATION SYSTEMATIC AND SINGLE PAYMENT INVESTMENT PLANS FOR THE ACCUMULATION OF SHARES OF AXE-HOUGHTON STOCK FUND, INC.

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that EFC Sponsors Corporation Systematic and Single Payment Investment Plans for the Accumulation of Shares of Axe-Houghton Stock Fund, Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18682 - April 28)

EFC SPONSORS CORPORATION SYSTEMATIC AND SINGLE PAYMENT INVESTMENT PLANS FOR THE ACCUMULATION OF SHARES OF SELIGMAN GROWTH FUND, INC.

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that EFC Sponsors Corporation Systematic and Single Payment Investment Plans for the Accumulation of Shares of Seligman Growth Fund, Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18683 - April 28)

MERRILL LYNCH BALANCED FUND FOR INVESTMENT AND RETIREMENT, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 26 to request a hearing on an application filed by Merrill Lynch Balanced Fund for Investment and Retirement, et al. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act to amend a previous order that granted applicants exemptive relief from Sections 18(f), 18(g) and 18(i) of the Act. CHESTNUT STREET CASH FUND, INC.

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that Chestnut Street Cash Fund, Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18685 - April 29)

#### HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ENTERGY CORPORATION, ET AL.

A supplemental order has been issued concerning a proposal by Entergy Corporation (Entergy), a registered holding company, its electric public-utility subsidiary companies, Arkansas Power & Light Company, Louisiana Power & Light Company, Mississippi Power & Light Company and New Orleans Public Service Inc. (collectively, Operating Companies), and the Operating Companies' fuel supply subsidiary company, System Fuels, Inc., and other Entergy subsidiaries, Entergy Services, Inc., System Energy Resources, Inc. and Entergy Operations, Inc. (Entergy Operations). The supplemental order authorizes Entergy to lend to Entergy Operations up to \$15 million outstanding at any one time, through November 30, 1992, under an amended loan agreement. (Rel. 35-25526)
