INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

BMC FUND, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 1, 1992 to request a hearing on an application filed by BMC Fund, Inc. (Fund) and Broyhill Investments, Inc. (BII) for an order under Section 17(b) of the Act granting an exemption from Section 17(a) to permit BII, an affiliated person of the Fund, to exercise a purchase option on certain real estate pursuant to the terms of a lease agreement between the Fund and BII. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CONSOLIDATED NATURAL GAS CO.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Consolidated Natural Gas Co. (Consolidated), a registered public utility holding company. Consolidated proposes, through December 31, 1995, to acquire through open market purchases a total of 4 million shares of its common stock; to hold all these shares as treasury stock (Treasury Stock); and to reissue such Treasury Stock in connection with various employee benefit plans and for corporate purposes.
