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INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

AIM CONVERTIBLE SECURITIES, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 2, 1992 to request a hearing on an application filed by AIM Convertible Securities, Inc., et al. for a conditional order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicants from the provisions of Section 12(d)(3) of the Act and Rule 12d3-1 thereunder. The exemptions apply to the extent necessary to permit them to invest in equity or convertible debt securities issued by foreign issuers that derived more than 15% of their gross revenues from their activities as a broker, dealer, underwriter, or investment adviser, provided that such investments meet the conditions described in proposed amended Rule 12d3-1. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NIAGARA MOHAWK POWER CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 1, 1992 to request a hearing on an application by Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation (Niagara), a New York public-utility holding company exempt from registration under Section 3(a)(2) of the Act pursuant to Rule 2. Niagara proposes to acquire all of the issued and outstanding shares of common stock of Syracuse Suburban Gas Company, Inc. (Syracuse), a privately held New York public-utility company. UTILICORP UNITED INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 1, 1992 to request a hearing on a proposal by UtiliCorp United Inc. (UtiliCorp), a public-utility holding company claiming exemption from registration under Rule 10. UtiliCorp proposes to acquire indirectly, through two to-be-formed, partially owned subsidiary companies (together, Subsidiary Companies), an ownership interest of 7.84% in Franchisee Corp., an Argentine public-utility company. It is expected that Franchisee Corp. and its parent, a Subsidiary Company (or the individual shareholders of the Subsidiary Company) will enter into a management contract with the Argentine government concerning the facilities of Franchisee Corp. UtiliCorp requests an order under Section 3(b) granting Subsidiary Companies and Franchisee Corp. exemptions from all

provisions of the Act. Alternatively, UtiliCorp requests an order of the Commission approving the proposed acquisition of Franchisee Corp. under Sections 9(a)(2) and 10 and granting Section 3(a)(5) exemptions to Subsidiary Companies. (Rel. 35-25530)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The New York Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-92-10) amending NYSE Rule 350 (Compensation or Gratuities to Employees of Others). Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of May 11. (Rel. 34-30679)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-92-09) to amend its procedures for handling market-on-close (MOC) orders on expiration Fridays to provide that no MOC order in any stock may be cancelled or reduced after 3:45 p.m. on expiration Fridays. In addition, the NYSE amends its procedures for handling MOC orders on expiration Fridays to indicate that the NYSE will publish imbalances in the so-called pilot stocks as soon as possible after 3:45 p.m. on those days. Further, the NYSE amends its procedures for handling MOC orders on expiration Fridays to provide that the 3:00 p.m. deadline for entry of MOC orders related to a strategy including any stock index futures, stock index options or options on stock index futures will apply to all NYSE stocks rather than only the pilot stocks.
