COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

PRESS CONFERENCE CONCERNING SALOMON BROTHERS SETTLEMENT

Chairman Breeden, joined by representatives of other agencies, including the Department of the Treasury and the Federal Reserve, held a press conference this morning at 11:30 concerning a settlement with Salomon Brothers. (Press Rel. 92-24)

CHAIRMAN BREEDEN HOLDS PRESS CONFERENCE

Chairman Breeden will address the Investment Company Institute conference at the Ramada Renaissance Tech World in Washington, D.C., on Thursday, May 21, at 10:30 a.m. Immediately after the speech, the Chairman will hold a press conference announcing the release of "Protecting Investors: A Half Century of Investment Company Regulation," a study of the Investment Company Act of 1940.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

WARREN COOK ORDERED TO CEASE AND DESIST

On May 18, the Commission issued an Order Instituting Cease and Desist Proceedings under Section 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Findings and Order against Warren C. Cook (Cook). The Order requires Cook to permanently cease and desist from committing or causing any violation of, or any future violation of, Section 16(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 16a-2 and 16a-3 promulgated thereunder. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Cook's Offer of Settlement in which, without admitting or denying the matters set forth in the Order, Cook consented to its issuance.

EXCHANGE COMMISSION

The Order finds that since 1976, Cook of Freeman, Maine, has been a Director of Chemfab Corporation (Chemfab), a Delaware corporation with headquarters in Merrimack, New Hampshire, and since November 1986, has been the President and Chief Executive Officer of Sugarloaf Mountain Corporation (SMC), a Maine corporation headquartered in Kingfield, Maine. The Order finds that from November 10, 1987 through September 3, 1991 Cook filed twenty-three Forms 4 from three to 143 weeks late reporting transactions of approximately \$3.3 million in violation of Section 16(a) of the Exchange Act and the rules thereunder. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

NEIL ROGEN ENJOINED, OTHER RELIEF ORDERED

The U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York entered a final judgment in a Commission enforcement action against Neil E. Rogen. Rogen was a founder and former chairman of Memory Metals, Inc., now known as Memry Corp., of Brookfield, Connecticut. The Court permanently enjoined Rogen from violating registration, antifraud and periodic and ownership reporting provisions of the federal securities laws and from acting as an officer or director of any company required to file reports with the Commission. The Court also ordered disgorgement of profits realized from sales of securities and imposed a penalty, but waived payment based upon Rogen's financial condition. Rogen consented to entry of the final judgment without admitting or denying the allegations made in the Commissions complaint, which was filed in March 1991 (LR-12812). [SEC v. Neil E. Rogen, 91 Civ. 1822, JSM, USDC S.D.N.Y.] (LR-13244)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

DR EUROPEAN EQUITY FUND INC.

An order has been issued on an application filed by DR European Equity Fund Inc. (Fund) under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that the Fund has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18712 - May 18)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORPORATION, ET AL.

A supplemental notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 8, 1992 to request a hearing on a proposal by Central and South West Corporation, a registered public-utility holding company, and certain of its subsidiaries to acquire interests in and finance the Brush Cogeneration Project and a related entity, a qualifying cogeneration facility. (Rel. 35-25535)

NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 8, 1992 to request a hearing on a proposal by National Fuel Gas Company (National), a registered holding company, and its subsidiary companies, Seneca Resources Corporation, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation, Empire Exploration, Inc. and National Fuel Gas Supply Corporation (Subsidiaries). National proposes to issue and sell up to 2.5 million shares of its common stock and use the proceeds to reimburse its treasury and to make loans and capital contributions to the Subsidiaries through April 30, 1994. JERSEY CENTRAL POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 8, 1992 to request a hearing on a proposal by Jersey Central Power & Light Company, a public-utility subsidiary company of General Public Utilities Corporation, a registered holding company, to sublease a portion of its storage capacity in The Merrill Creek Reservoir Project to a nonaffiliate company pursuant to a sublease agreement. WEST TEXAS UTILITIES COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by West Texas Utilities Company (WTU), an electric public-utility subsidiary company of Central and South West Corporation, a registered holding company. WTU proposes to issue and sell first mortgage bonds (Bonds) in an aggregate principal amount of up to \$25 million, in one or more series, from time to time through December 31, 1993 under an exception from the competitive bidding requirements of Rule 50 under Subsection (a)(5) thereunder. The Bonds may be issued pursuant to one or more deviations from the Commission's Statement of Policy Regarding First Mortgage Bonds Subject to the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935. CONSOLIDATED NATURAL GAS CO.

A supplemental order has been issued correcting the Commission's order dated May 8, 1992 (HCAR No. 25528) authorizing a proposal by Consolidated Natural Gas Co. (Consolidated), a registered public utility holding company. Consolidated proposes, through December 31, 1995, to acquire through open market purchases a total of 4 million shares of its common stock; to hold all these shares as treasury stock; and to reissue such treasury stock in connection with various employee benefit plans and for corporate purposes.
