FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT RELEASES

FOIA APPEAL OF MICHAEL ROTHMAN

The General Counsel sent a letter to Michael Rothman affirming the Freedom of Information Act Officer's determination to withhold certain documents submitted to the Commission by Prudential Bache Securities, Inc. regarding that firm's compliance with Securities Exchange Act Release No. 22755. The FOIA Officer had determined that the documents should be withheld pursuant to FOIA Exemptions 4 and 8, 5 U.S.C. 552(b)(4) and (8), and the Commission's rules implementing those exemptions, 17 C.F.R. 200.80(b)(4) and (8). CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PHILIP GRATZ PERMANENTLY ENJOINED

The Commission announced that on April 30, 1992 the Honorable Edward B. Davis, U.S. District Judge for the Southern District of Florida, entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Relief Upon Default (Final Judgment) against Philip R. Gratz (Gratz) of Marlton, New Jersey, an associated person of a broker-dealer registered with the Commission. The Final Judgment permanently enjoins Gratz from violating the registration, antifraud, and the broker-dealer books and records provisions of the federal securities laws. Gratz was ordered to disgorge all ill-gotten gains and to pay civil penalties pursuant to the Penny Stock Reform Act of 1990.

The complaint filed on September 30, 1991 alleges that Gratz opened several nominee and personal brokerage accounts, on behalf of two other defendants, to conceal and facilitate their illegal trading in Delta Rental Systems, Inc. (Delta) stock. Gratz, while actively recommending and selling Delta stock to customers, made omissions and misrepresentations of material facts concerning his personal transactions in Delta stock and his transactions with Delta, its officers and directors and a major shareholder of Delta. Gratz failed to disclose that he fraudulently opened and controlled a nominee brokerage account through which he sold at least 175,000 shares of Delta stock generating gross proceeds of over \$401,000. U.S. SECURITIES EYFER THE VERMASSION

COMPLAINT AGAINST ALBERT GRIGGS, JR.

On May 21, the Commission filed a complaint in U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against G. Albert Griggs, Jr., a former bond analyst with an investment adviser, and John D. Collins II seeking injunctive relief and disgorgement. The complaint was based on Griggs' and Collins' alleged violations of or aiding and abetting violations of Sections 10(b), 13(a) and 13(b)(2)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, Rules 10b-5, 12b-20, 13a-1 and 13b2-1 thereunder; Section 204 of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940, Rules 204-1(b)(1), (2) and (3) thereunder; and Section 17(e)(1) of the Investment Company Act of 1940. The complaint alleges that Griggs and Collins engaged in a fraudulent scheme with a senior officer of The Cooper Companies, Inc. in which Griggs told the officer which high yield bonds he was recommending to funds advised by his employer. The officer caused accounts of his failly and Cooper to purchase such bonds, then to sell them to such funds at inflated prices and diverted Cooper funds to Griggs and Collins. The complaint also alleges that Griggs entered into fraudulent schemes with two other individuals. Griggs and Collins also consented to entry of administrative bar orders. [SEC v. G. CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

INDICTMENT CHARGES ALEXANDER STEIN WITH SECURITIES FRAUD, MAIL FRAUD, WIRE FRAUD AND MONEY LAUNDERING

The Commission and Charles H. Turner, U.S. Attorney for the District of Oregon, announced the filing of a forty-nine-count indictment in the U.S. District Court for the District of Oregon, on April 30, 1992 against Alexander V. Stein, formerly of Portland, Oregon. Stein was arrested on May 7, 1992 in Salem, Oregon. The indictment charges Stein with Securities Fraud, Mail Fraud, Wire Fraud and Money Laundering in connection with a scheme that obtained over \$5 million from the public through investments in what Stein called fully hedged arbitrage transactions. The indictment also alleges that Stein forged multi-million dollar telecommunication contracts, brokerage records, bank statements and other documents in an attempt to lull investors into believing that he would be able to repay them. SCOTT'S INDICTED ON REAL ESTATE DEALS

The Commission and the U.S. Attorney for the Northern District of Illinois announced that on April 2, 1992 a seventy-count indictment against Richard E. Scott and Douglas W. Scott was filed charging racketeering, conspiracy and mail fraud and against Richard E. Scott additionally charging the making of false statements to the Commission in Forms D in violation of 18 U.S.C. §1001. The indictment charges that from September 1983 through December 1985 the Scotts', through their companies IRE, Inc., a corporate general partner for at least 35 real estate limited partnerships, and Elwyn, Willbert and Haig, Inc., a registered broker-dealer, obtained approximately \$4 million from approximately 140 investors in limited partnership interests by means of false and fraudulent representations and used monies obtained to, in part, satisfy substantial personal and corporate debts. Previously, the Chicago Regional Office of the Commission brought injunctive actions and administrative proceedings against the Scotts', IRE and/or EWH for violations of the registration, antifraud and net capital provisions of the federal securities laws. ZWEIG TAX-FREE FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 15, 1992 to request a hearing on an application filed by Premier Income Fund for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18715 - May 19)

MONARCH LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

A conditional temporary order of exemption for a period not to exceed one year and a notice of an application for a permanent order have been issued on an application filed under Section 9(c) of the Investment Company Act by Salomon Brothers Asset Management Inc and Salomon Brothers Inc for an exemption from the provisions of Section 9(a) of the Act. The temporary order relieves applicants from any ineligibility resulting from a permanent injunction entered by the U. S. District Court for the Southern District of New York restraining applicants from violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, and Sections 10(b), 15(c)(1), and 17(a)(1) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 10b-5, 15c1-2, 17a-3, and 17a-4 thereunder. Interested persons may request a hearing on the application for permanent exemption or ask to be notified if a hearing is ordered by submitting a request no later than 5:30 p.m. on the thirtieth day after publication of a notice in the Federal Register of the filing with the Commission of the report of the Consultants as described in the notice and application. NUVEEN CALIFORNIA PERFORMANCE PLUS MUNICIPAL FUND, INC., ET AL.
