ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST ALAN STERN AND DAVID BORSACK

The Commission announced the institution of administrative proceedings pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Alan M. Stern (Stern) and David S. Borsack (Borsack). Stern was the president and chief compliance officer of Levco Securities Corp. (Levco), a defunct broker-dealer. Borsack was a Levco sales manager and registered representative. Simultaneously with the institution of these proceedings, the Commission accepted Stern's and Borsack's Offers of Settlement in which, without admitting or denying the findings (except as to the entry of the injunctions described below), each consented to the entry of a Commission Order barring him from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company, with a right to reapply after three The administrative proceedings were based upon the entry of permanent injunctions against both Stern and Borsack on April 27, 1992 by the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York. The Commission's complaint alleged that Stern and Borsack, while at Levco, violated and aided and abetted violations of the antifraud sections of the federal securities laws in connection a scheme to manipulate the initial public offering and aftermarket trading of securities of Keller Industries The complaint also alleged that Stern effected fraudulent transactions in other securities and caused Levco to file a false Form BD and to fail to keep certain required records. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES ROBERT NAVARRE II, STEVEN TIMYAN, PHILIP TIMYAN, JOHN RENTAS AND JAMES MARTIN, JR.

The Commission announced the filing of a civil action on May 21 against Robert W. Navarre II (Navarre), Steven J. Timyan (S. Timyan), Philip J. Timyan (P. Timyan), John Rentas (Rentas) and James V. Martin, Jr. (Martin) seeking permanent injunctions, disgorgement, prejudgment interest and civil penalties under the Insider Trading Sanctions Act of 1984.



The The Committee

The Commission alleges that in September 1987, Martin, then a manager of acquisitions for the General Electric Credit Corporation (GECC), presently known as General Electric Capital Corporation, learned of the impending acquisition of Gelco Corporation (Gelco) by GECC. In breach of his duty of confidentiality to GECC, Martin communicated this material, nonpublic information to his brother-in-law, Navarre, who traded.

The Commission further alleges that Navarre communicated this misappropriated information to S. Timyan, his broker at Robert W. Baird & Co., Inc. (Baird). S. Timyan tipped P. Timyan, his business partner and cousin. The Timyans then embarked on a concerted effort to purchase Gelco stock for themselves, their family and their customers at Baird. Additionally, the Commission alleges that Navarre tipped Rentas, a business associate, who purchased Gelco and tipped family members and friends who traded. The alleged illegal transactions in Gelco securities generated total profits of at least \$469,425. [SEC v. Robert W. Navarre, Steven J. Timyan, Philip J. Timyan, John Rentas and James V. CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

ARTHUR NUGENT PLEADS GUILTY

The Commission and the U.S. Attorney for the Eastern District of Michigan announced that on May 21 Arthur F. Nugent III (Nugent) pled guilty in the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan to a one-count criminal information charging violations of Sections 10(b) and 32(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. According to the information, Nugent engaged in a scheme to defraud investors by making false representations as to his employment background and qualifications and falsely representing that he would invest money in specific stocks to be held in separate accounts for the investors and that the funds in the accounts would remain the exclusive property of the investors. According to the information, Nugent also engaged in a scheme to defraud investors by providing false documents to satisfy the investors that their investments were safe and successful and obtaining more than \$200,000 from the investors as a result Sentencing was scheduled for August 4, 1992. of the misrepresentations. Commission had referred this matter to the U.S. Attorney for the Eastern District of Michigan. [U.S. v. Arthur F. Nugent III, Crim. No. 92-80410, E.D. Mich.] (LR-13249)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NORTH DAKOTA DOUBLE TAX-EXEMPT BOND FUND, INC.

The AES CORPORATION

An order has been issued granting an order of exemption under Section 3(a)(5) from all provisions of the Public Utility Holding Company Act except Section 9(a)(2) to The AES Corporation (AES), a Delaware corporation engaged in the development, ownership, operation and maintenance of qualifying cogeneration facilities in the United States. AES, through a wholly owned British subsidiary company, proposes to acquire and operate two existing electric power plants in Northern Ireland. (Rel. 35-25539)

NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY ET AL.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing National Fuel Gas Company (National), a registered holding company, and its wholly owned subsidiary companies, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation, Penn-York Energy Corporation, National Fuel Gas Supply Corporation and Seneca Resources Corporation (collectively, Subsidiaries) to engage in financing. National proposes to issue and sell in one or more transactions through December 31, 1993 up to an aggregate principal amount of \$128.5 million of medium-term notes (MTNs). In addition, National proposes to lend the proceeds from the issuance of the MTNs to the Subsidiaries in exchange for unsecured notes. (Rel. 35-25540)

NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY, ET AL.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing National Fuel Gas Company (National), a registered holding company, and its wholly owned subsidiary company, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation (Distribution) to engage in financing. National proposes to issue and sell in one or more transactions through December 31, 1993 up to an aggregate principal amount of \$150 million of medium-term notes (New MTNs), under an exception from competitive bidding. In addition, National proposes to lend the proceeds from the issuance of the New MTNs to Distribution in exchange for unsecured notes. (Rel. 35-25541)

APPALACHIAN POWER COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Appalachian Power Company, an electric public-utility subsidiary company of American Electric Power Company, Inc., a registered holding company, to effect the refunding of up to \$40 million of pollution control revenue bonds issued in connection with the financing of pollution control facilities.
