ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PETER BUTLER SUSPENDED

The Commission issued an order instituting administrative proceedings, making findings and imposing remedial sanctions against Peter E. Butler. In the order, the Commission found that while employed as a research analyst with PaineWebber, Incorporated in 1986, Butler willfully violated Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder by engaging in a course of conduct operating as a fraud or in a scheme to defraud to affect the market price of the common stock of Memory Metals, Inc. The Commission suspended Butler from association with a broker or dealer, investment company, investment adviser or municipal securities dealers for six months. Butler consented to the issuance of the order without admitting or denying the Commission's findings. (Rel. 34-30788)


HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

HOUSTON INDUSTRIES INCORPORATED

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 29 to request a hearing on an application by Houston Industries Incorporated, a Texas public-utility holding company exempt from registration under Section 3(a)(1) of the Public Utility Holding Company Act pursuant to Rule 2. The application is in connection with the proposed acquisition of an interest in an Argentine public-utility company that will provide electric power distribution and marketing services to approximately one-half of the City of Buenos Aires and its suburbs. SYSTEM FUELS, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 29 to request a hearing on a proposal by System Fuels, Inc. (SFI), a fuel supply company jointly owned by Arkansas Power & Light Company (AP&L), Louisiana Power & Light Company (LP&L), Mississippi Power & Light Company and New Orleans Public Service Inc. (all companies collectively, Applicants). Each of the Applicants is an electric public utility subsidiary of Entergy Corporation, a registered holding company. The Applicants propose that AP&L assume SFI's existing rights and obligations under several leases of coal railroad cars. (Rel. 35-25551)

ENTERGY CORPORATION, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 29 to request a hearing on a proposal by Entergy Corporation (Entergy), a registered holding company, its wholly owned nonutility subsidiary company, Electec, Inc. (Electec) and Entergy Power, Inc. (EPI), a wholly owned nonutility subsidiary company of Electec. Entergy proposes to acquire up to a 5.99% voting interest in a steam electric generating company (Costanera) in Buenos Aires, Argentina (Alternative A). The proposed acquisition will be made indirectly through a proposed Argentine subsidiary company of Electec (Entergy S.A.). A possibility exists that Entergy may indirectly acquire up to a 12.0% voting interest in Costanera (Alternative B). Under Alternative A, Entergy's obligations are not expected to exceed \$22.5 million and under Alternative B, Entergy's obligations will not exceed \$45 million. Electec proposes that it provide consulting services to Costanera and seeks relief under Section 13 of the Public Utility Holding Company Act regarding such transactions. Electec also proposes to obtain services at cost from various associate companies, including EPI. Alternative B, Entergy requests an exemption under Section 3(b) of the Act for Entergy S.A., Costanera and Electec, and under Section 3(a)(5) for Entergy S.A. and Electec. (Rel. 35-25551)

THE SOUTHERN COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 29 to request a hearing on a proposal by The Southern Company (Southern), a registered holding company. Southern proposes to make capital contributions, from time to time through June 30, 1994 to its wholly owned electric utility subsidiary, Mississippi Power Company, not to exceed the aggregate amount of \$100 million.
