COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

CHAIRMAN BREEDEN TO HOLD PRESS CONFERENCE

Chairman Breeden will hold a press conference on Tuesday, June 23, at 2:00 p.m. in Room 1C30. At the press conference he will discuss the proposals concerning proxy rules under Section 14(a) of the Securities Exchange Act that the Commission will have considered at its open meeting earlier in the day. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NATIONS FUND, ET AL.

A conditional order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Nations Fund, et al. from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c) and 22(d) of the Act and Rule 22dc-1 thereunder. The exemptions apply to the extent necessary to permit them to impose a contingent deferred sales charge (CDSC) on certain redemptions of shares and to waive the CDSC under certain circumstances. (Rel. IC-18794 - June 17)

MONARCH LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued to Monarch Life Insurance Company, Monarch Life Insurance Company Separate Account VA (Account VA), First Variable Life Insurance Company, First Variable Annuity Fund A (Account A) and First Variable Annuity Fund E (Account E) pursuant to Section 26(b) of the Investment Company Act. The order approves the substitution of certain securities issued by Variable Investors Series Trust and held by Account VA, Account A and Account E to fund variable annuity contracts issued by the Applicants. (Rel. IC-18795 - June 17)

IDS LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY OF NEW YORK, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting IDS Life Insurance Company of New York, IDS Life of New York Account SLB (Variable Account) and Shearson Lehman Brothers Inc. from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act. The exemptions apply to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of a mortality and expense risk charge from the assets of the Variable Account under a master group combination fixed and variable annuity contract and related certificates. (Rel. IC-18796 - June 1717)

EAST-WEST EUROPE FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 13, 1992 to request a hearing on an application filed by East-West Europe Fund, Inc. for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that applicant has ceased to be an investment company. PRINCIPAL MUTUAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 13, 1992 to request a hearing on an application filed by Principal Mutual Life Insurance Company, Principal Mutual Life Insurance Company Separate Account B (Separate Account B) and Princor Financial Services Corporation (collectively, Applicants). The application is for an order of the Commission pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Applicants from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(35), 26(a)(2)(C), 27(a)(2)&(3) and 27(c)(2) of the Act. The exemptions would apply to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of a premium based sales load with volume discounts under certain group variable annuity contracts, the separate payment of sales load expenses and the deduction of a mortality and expense risk charge from the assets of Separate Account B in connection with the group variable annuity contracts. UNUM LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY OF AMERICA, ET AL.

An order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting UNUM Life Insurance Company of America, VA-I Separate Account (VA-I) and UNUM Sales Corporation from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act. The exemptions apply to the extent necessary to permit the assessment of a mortality and expense risk charge from the assets of VA-I under certain group variable annuity contracts. (Rel. IC-18799 - June 18)

IDS LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 13, 1992 to request a hearing on an application filed by IDS Life Insurance Company and IDS Life Accounts F, IZ, JZ, G, H and N (Variable Accounts) for an order pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act. The exemptions would apply to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of a mortality and expense risk charge from the assets of the Variable Accounts under a group, unallocated fixed/variable annuity contract for qualified retirement plans. (Rel. IC-18800 - June 18)

STATE MUTUAL LIFE ASSURANCE COMPANY OF AMERICA, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 13, 1992 to request a hearing on an application filed by State Mutual Life Assurance Company of America, State Mutual Separate Account I, and Allmerica Investments, Inc. (Applicants) for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting them from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act. The exemptions would apply to the extent necessary to permit the assessment of a mortality and expense risk charge under certain group combination fixed/variable annuity contracts. (Rel. IC-18801 - June 18)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The <u>Midwest Clearing Corporation</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-MCC-92-8) to amend the Fund/SERV interface service fee schedule. The proposed rule change became effective immediately upon filing with the Commission. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 22. The <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-92-20) to rescind the Form 211 fee established in (SR-NASD-91-71) and refund all Form 211 fees previously collected. The proposed rule change became effective immediately upon filing with the Commission. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 22. (Rel. 34-30805)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-91-58) to amend Part III of Schedule D to the NASD By-Laws to create Non-Quantitative Designation Criteria for Issuers that are Partnerships. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 22. (Rel. 34-30811)

The Depository Trust Company filed a proposed rule change (SR-DTC-92-02) that would allow DTC to provide to its members through DTC's Participant Terminal System the Networking service provided by the National Securities Clearing Corporation. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 22. (Rel. 34-30813)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE
