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ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

CRAIG AND ASSOCIATES, INC.; GARY CRAIG CENSURED

The Commission announced that on June 22 public administrative proceedings were instituted against Craig and Associates, Inc. (Associates) of Seattle, Washington, and Gary L. Craig (Craig) of Mercer Island, Washington, pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. With Associates' and Craig's consent, the Commission found that from January 27, 1988 through December 1, 1989 they failed to properly supervise Stephen J. Klos, registered representative of Associates. The Commission censured Associates and Craig and ordered them to comply with certain undertakings concerning, among other things, supervision of registered On April 13, 1992 the U.S. District Court for the Western District representatives. of Washington enjoined Klos from violations of the registration, anti-fraud and broker-dealer registration provisions of the securities laws in connection with alleged material misrepresentations and omissions made in the offer and sale of more than \$3 million in unregistered Fortune Group, Inc. notes and bonds. On May 21, 1992 the Commission barred Klos from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company. (Rel. 34-30847)

DENNIS DENOBLE BARRED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against Dennis Denoble (Denoble). From October 1981 to at least on or about April 1990, Denoble was a registered representative of broker-dealers registered with the Commission. The proceedings were instituted under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act. Simultaneously, Denoble submitted an offer of settlement which the Commission accepted. Accordingly, the Commission entered an order making findings, among other things, that on April 15, 1992, in SEC v. Arnold Kimmes, et al., (89 C 5942, N.D. Ill.), the Court entered an order of permanent injunction against Denoble, with his consent and without admitting or denying the allegations contained in the complaint, enjoining him from violating and aiding and abetting violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act and Sections 10(b) and 17(a) of the Securities Exchange Act and Rules 10b-5 and 17a-3 thereunder. The complaint alleges that Denoble participated in a scheme to defraud public investors and violated record-keeping provisions of the federal securities laws by opening accounts which he knew or was reckless in not knowing were undisclosed nominee accounts and purchasing in such accounts securities in the initial public offering of GSS Venture Capital Corporation. The order bars Denoble from associating with any regulated industry for four years. (Rel. 34-30846)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

JOHN DECKER, OTHERS ENJOINED

The Commission filed a complaint in the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Virginia at Roanoke against John G. Decker, Benjamin A. Cooper and Thomas W. Smith. The Complaint alleges that on June 7, 1988, Decker, then Chief Operating Officer and President of Pannill Knitting Co. Inc. with principal offices in Martinsville, Virginia, communicated material nonpublic information concerning a tender offer by Sara Lee Corporation for Pannill's shares, to his friends, Cooper and Smith, and recommended purchase of Pannill shares to certain family members, and that such persons purchased a total of 13,050 shares of Pannill before the tender offer announcement.

Without admitting or denying the allegations of the Complaint, the defendants consented to entry of a Final Judgment permanently enjoining them from violating Sections 10(b) and 14(e) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 10b-5 and 14e-3 thereunder, ordering Decker to disgorge \$10,181, plus interest, representing profits made by certain members of his family and ordering Cooper and Smith to disgorge their trading profits of \$17,875 and \$7,150 respectively, plus interest. The Final Judgment orders Decker, Cooper and Smith to pay civil penalties in the amount of \$37,537, \$17,875 and \$7,150, respectively. [SEC v. John G. Decker, Benjamin A. Cooper and Thomas W. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-92-10) filed by the <u>Chicago Board Options Exchange</u> which extends until August, 31, 1992 a pilot program that provides a 50% rebate on transaction and trade match fees for "box" trades by public customers in Standard & Poor's 500 Stock Index options, has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 29. (Rel. 34-30857)
