CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CIVIL ACTION AGAINST PROGRAMMING AND SYSTEMS, INC.

On July 1, the Commission filed an action in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against Programming and Systems, Inc. (PSI) of New York, alleging that PSI violated the antifraud, reporting, books and records and internal controls provisions of the federal securities laws, and seeking a permanent injunction, civil penalties and other equitable relief.

The complaint charges that PSI's financial statements filed with the Commission in PSI's Annual Report on Form 10-K for its 1989 fiscal year materially understated net income before income taxes, and that PSI's financial statements filed with the Commission for its 1990 and 1991 fiscal years materially overstated net income before income taxes, through the use of unsupported adjustments to the balance sheet and income statement accounts of PSI's subsidiaries.

Simultaneously with filing the complaint, the Commission filed a Stipulation and Order by which PSI agreed to the appointment of a Special Agent to review, monitor and approve all expenditures of PSI over \$10,000 and to arrange for a prompt accounting of PSI's financial condition.

Previously the Commission suspended trading in the securities of PSI for the period from June 18, 1992 to July 1, 1992 in view of information that the PSI's financial statements for its 1991 fiscal year substantially and materially overstated the company's income. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

KEMPER TARGET MATURITY INCOME FUND, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 23 to request a hearing on an application filed by Kemper Target Maturity Income Fund, et al. The application is for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicants from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c) and 22(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder so that they may impose a contingent deferred sales charge on certain redemptions of their shares. (Rel. IC-18814 - June 29)

HAWAII PACIFIC FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 27 to request a hearing on an application filed by Hawaii Pacific Fund, Inc. for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18815 - June 29)

T. ROWE PRICE SPECTRUM FUND, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 23 to request a hearing on an application filed by T. Rowe Price Spectrum Fund, Inc., et al. for an order to amend an existing order. The existing order granted an exemption from Sections 12(d)(1) and 17(a) pursuant to Sections 6(c) and 17(b), and permitted certain joint arrangements pursuant to Section 17(d) and Rule 17d-1. Applicants seek to amend the existing order to remove a condition which limits sales of the shares of the T. Rowe Price Spectrum Fund, Inc. to not more than \$30,000 per investor per calendar year. (Re1. IC-18816 - June 29)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

KENETECH CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 20 to request a hearing on an application by Kenetech Corporation and its wholly owned subsidiary company, U.S. Windpower Inc. The application is for an order under Section 3(a)(5) of the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935 exempting each as a foreign holding company that derives no material part of its income from public-utility operations within the United States. The applicants propose to engage in the ownership and operation of wind turbine electric generating plants to be built outside the United States. (Rel. 35-25563)

SEAGULL ENERGY CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 20 to request a hearing on an application by Seagull Energy Corporation (Seagull), a gas public-utility company. Seagull proposes to acquire indirectly, through wholly owned subsidiaries organized under Argentine law, 10% or more in one or more to-be-formed Argentine public-utility subsidiary companies (Argentine Utility Companies). Additionally, a foreign subsidiary of Seagull (Newco) will enter into a management agreement for the operation of the Argentine Utility Companies. Seagull requests an order under Section 3(b) of the Act granting an unqualified exemption from all provisions of the Act for each Argentine Utility Company, Newco and a subsidiary organized under Argentine law to hold its interest in each Argentine Utility Company. Alternatively, Seagull requests orders under Section 3(a)(5) granting it, and its subsidiaries that would be holding companies as a result of the proposed transactions, exemptions under Section 3(a)(5) from all provisions of the Act, except Section 9(a)(2). CONSOLIDATED NATURAL GAS COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 20 to request a hearing on a proposal by Consolidated Natural Gas Company (Consolidated), a registered holding company, and its wholly-owned non-utility subsidiary company, CNG Trading Company (Trading). The application seeks, pursuant to Section 2(b) of the Gas Related Activities Act of 1990, to remove the restriction on revenues Trading can earn from off-system, non-associated companies contained in the original Commission order authorizing the creation of Trading. ENTERGY CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 20 to request a hearing on a proposal by Entergy Corporation (Entergy), a registered holding company, to hold acquired shares of its common stock (Common Stock) either as treasury shares for later reissuance or cancel the Common Stock and return them to the status of authorized but unissued, pursuant to an amendment to Entergy's charter. OHIO VALLEY ELECTRIC CORPORATION

law, up to a 40% interest in Loy Yang B Venture (Venture). Venture is a to-be-formed indirect partially owned subsidiary company of MEC that will acquire the Loy Yang B electric generating facilities under construction in the State of Victoria, Australia (Power Station). Additionally, Mission Energy Management Australia, Ltd. (MEMA), an indirect wholly owned foreign subsidiary of MEC, will operate the Power Station. (Rel. 35-25564; International Series Rel. 405)

NORTHEAST UTILITIES, ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Northeast Utilities (Northeast), a registered holding company, its service company subsidiary, Northeast Utilities Service Company, and two of its electric public-utility subsidiary companies, Connecticut Light & Power Company and Yankee Atomic Electric Company (collectively, Applicants). The Applicants have been authorized to form North Atlantic Energy Service Corporation, a wholly owned subsidiary company of Northeast that will assume operating responsibility for the Seabrook Nuclear Power Project in Seabrook, New Hampshire. (Rel. 35-25565)

CONSOLIDATED NATURAL GAS COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Consolidated Natural Gas Company (Consolidated), a registered holding company, and its wholly owned subsidiaries. CNG Research Company; CNG Storage Service Company; CNG Trading Company; Consolidated Natural Gas Service Company, Inc.; CNG Coal Company; CNG Producing Company (Producing), and its subsidiary, CNG Pipeline Company (Pipeline); CNG Transmission Corporation; and Consolidated's public-utility subsidiary companies, The Peoples Natural Gas Company; The East Ohio Gas Company; The River Gas Company; Virginia Natural Gas, Inc. (Virginia Gas); Hope Gas, Inc.; and West Ohio Gas Company (Subsidiaries). Through June 30, 1993, Consolidated may engage in up to \$800 million in short-term commercial paper financing and may borrow up to \$600 million, short-Through June 30, 1993, Consolidated may also make up to \$1,050 term, from banks. million in open account advances and/or long-term loans to, and/or capital stock purchases from, its Subsidiaries. Through June 30, 1993, Producing may make up to \$1 million in open account advances and/or long-term loans to, or purchases of common stock from, Pipeline and increases may be made in any Subsidiary's authorized common stock. Jurisdiction is reserved over Consolidated's acquisition of interests in longterm debt issued by Virginia Gas. (Rel. 35-25566)

NEW ENGLAND POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by New England Power Company (NEPCO), an electric public-utility subsidiary company of New England Electric System, a registered holding company. NEPCO proposes to indemnify its subsidiary, Yankee Atomic Electric Company (Yankee), under a proposed Nuclear Support Services Agreement between Yankee and North Atlantic Energy Service Corporation, which is to be formed as a wholly owned subsidiary company of Northeast Utilities, a registered holding company, that will assume operating responsibilities for the Seabrook Nuclear Power Plant in Seabrook, New Hampshire. NEPCO requests authority to consummate the proposed transaction within one year from the date of the Commission's order approving such indemnification. (Rel. 35-25567)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-92-19) to notify the Commission of the reclassification of securities in the appropriate Small Order Execution System maximum order size tiers. The NASD has designated this proposal as a "stated policy, practice, or interpretation with respect to the meaning, administration or enforcement of an existing rule." The proposed rule change became effective upon filing with the Commission. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of July 6. (Rel. 34-30867)

The <u>Pacific Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-PSE-92-16) to change the alternate specialist fees. The proposed rule change became effective upon filing with the Commission. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of July 6. (Rel. 34-30876)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the <u>National Association of</u> <u>Securities Dealers</u> (SR-NASD-92-25) pursuant to Section 19(b)(1) of the Securities Exchange Act and Rule 19b-4 thereunder. The proposed rule change amends schedule D to the By-laws to require members to furnish certain information on customer confirmation forms and to clarify the volume reporting obligations of market makers maintaining quotations in convertible debt securities in regular NASDAQ. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of July 6. (Rel. 34-30871)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the <u>New York Stock Exchange</u> (SR-NYSE-92-10) to amend NYSE Rule 350 (Compensation or Gratuities to Employees of Others). (Rel. 34-30877)
