RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

FINAL RULE

The Commission has issued a release adopting amendments to Rule 52 [17 CFR §250.52] under the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935 (Act) [15 U.S.C. 79 et seq.]. Rule 52 exempts from prior Commission authorization the issuance and sale of certain securities by a public-utility subsidiary company of a registered holding company, in accordance with the terms and conditions of the rule. Rule 52 also exempts the acquisition by a parent holding company of the securities issued by an existing public-utility subsidiary company under the rule. The amendment deletes six of the eight conditions to the rule and broadens the types of securities within the exemption. The amendment also clarifies the scope of the rule in certain minor respects. (Rel. 35-25573)

PROPOSED RULES AND REQUEST FOR COMMENT

The Commission has issued a release requesting comment on proposed amendments to Rules 45 and 52 under the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935 (Act) [15 U.S.C. 79 et seq.]. Rule 52 exempts certain financings by public-utility subsidiaries of registered holding companies. The Commission now seeks comment on the need to further amend Rule 52 to exempt from prior Commission authorization additional public-utility financings, as well as certain financings by nonutility subsidiaries of registered holding companies. The release also seeks comment on the need to amend Rule 45(b)(4) to remove current restrictions under the rule on capital contributions and open account advances, without interest, by a company in a registered holding company system to its subsidiary company.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

NASD ACTION AGAINST F.B. HORNER & ASSOCIATES AND FRED HORNER AFFIRMED

The Commission has affirmed NASD disciplinary action against F.B. Horner & Associates, Inc. of New York City, a former NASD member firm, and Fred B. Horner, the firm's president. The NASD censured respondents and fined them \$99,201.20, jointly and severally.

The Commission found, as had the NASD, that in 1988 respondents charged a bank unfair markups of 8.09% and 6.91%, a total dollar markup of \$272,908, in two sales of principal-only CMO bonds. Rejecting applicants' argument that any violations on their part were merely technical, the Commission stated that it "[does] not consider the overcharging of a customer a technical infraction." CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT FILED BY SECURITIES INVESTOR PROTECTION CORPORATION

The Commission announced today that the Honorable Shirley Wohl Kram, United States District Judge for the Southern District of New York, entered an Order and Protective Decree, adjudicating that the customers of W. H. Farr & Co., Inc. (W. H. Farr) are in need of the protection provided by the Securities Investor Protection Act and appointing a trustee and a counsel to the trustee for the liquidation of W. H. Farr's business. W. H. Farr is the successor corporation to Sunrise Securities, Inc., a broker-dealer which has been registered with the Commission since on or about January 4, 1990.

SIPC's Complaint and Application alleges that W. H. Farr was in danger of failing to meet customer obligations and was not in compliance with the applicable requirements under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and the rules of the Commission and the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. with respect to financial responsibility.

W. H. Farr consented to the entry of the Order and Protective Decree without admitting or denying the allegations contained in the Complaint and Application. [Securities Investor Protection Corporation v. W.H. Farr & Co., Inc., 92 Civ. 4653, USDC SDNY] (LR-13306)

CROWELL & COMPANY, INC. AND PHILLIP MCELHANEY ENJOINED

The Commission announced that on July 1 Crowell & Company, Inc. and Phillip R. McElhaney, both of Augusta, Georgia, were permanently enjoined from future violations, and from aiding and abetting future violations of the reporting provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and rules thereunder. The case involved an undisclosed change in the accounting treatment of a prior merger transaction without prior approval by the staff of the Commission, resulting in material misrepresentations and omissions in the financial statements contained in an annual report. CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

RICHARD HERMANSON SENTENCED

The Commission and the U.S. Attorney for the District of Utah announced the sentencing on May 21, 1992 of Richard Scott Hermanson (Hermanson) of Bountiful, Utah. Chief Judge Bruce S. Jenkins ordered Hermanson to serve thirty months on probation and to pay a fine of \$2,500.00 or to perform eighty hours of community service.

Hermanson pled guilty on January 29, 1992 to charges of conspiracy, securities fraud and preparation of false tax forms. Hermanson admitted that he conspired with others to obtain all of the stock of a corporation; to list the corporation's stock in the National Quotation Bureau, Inc.'s "pink sheets"; and to recruit nominee shareholders and stockbrokers to engage in a market manipulation to artificially raise the price of the company's stock. Documentation submitted to the National Quotation Bureau, Inc. failed to disclose the control and the planned market manipulation of the stock of the corporation.

Hermanson further admitted that he aided and assisted in and caused the preparation of false Forms 1099 that were submitted to the Internal Revenue Service relative to the above-described nominee transactions.
