EXCHANGE COMMISSION

CIVIL ACTION AGAINST CHARLES KEATING, JR. AND OTHERS

The U.S. District Court for the Central District of California has entered Final Judgments of Permanent Injunction against Judy Wischer, who was President and Chief Operating Officer of American Continental Corporation (ACC) and an officer of Lincoln Savings and Loan Association (Lincoln), and Mark Sauter, formerly Corporate Counsel with ACC. In addition, Andrew Ligget, the former Chief Financial Officer of ACC and director of Lincoln, has consented to the entry of a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction in that action. Wischer, Ligget and Sauter have consented, without admitting or denying any of the allegations in the complaint, to the entry of Final Judgments of Permanent Injunction against future violations of the antifraud and reporting provisions of the federal securities laws alleged in the Commission's complaint, and have agreed to cooperate with the Commission in connection with this matter. All three were defendants in the civil injunctive action brought against Charles Keating, Jr., and others. In addition, Wischer has consented to a provision permanently and unconditionally prohibiting her from serving as an officer or director of any publicly-traded company pursuant to Section 21(d)(2) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. ## SAM RECILE AND OTHERS ENJOINED

The Commission announced that on July 29, 1992 the Honorable Judge Marcel Livaudais, Jr., of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Louisiana, granted the Commission's motion for summary judgment against Sam J. Recile., V. Rae Phillips, Hannover Corporation of America, Redwood Raevine Corporation, Place Vendome, Inc., Kenneth Kleinke and Al Eden.

In granting the Commission's motion, Judge Livaudais found that the defendants had violated and aided and abetted violations of Sections 5 and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, Sections 10(b) and 15(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder by fraudulently selling unregistered securities in connection with the purported development of a shopping mall in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. Judge Livaudais found that the defendants had made numerous misrepresentations and misleading omissions as part of their offering and that the defendants had misappropriated investor funds for personal purposes. Among other things, Judge Livaudais found that Recile and Phillips had used investor funds to buy and luxuriously furnish two houses for themselves.

Judge Livaudais permanently enjoined the defendants from future violations, appointed a receiver for the corporate defendants and ordered that the defendants pay disgorgement, prejudgment interest and civil penalties in amounts to be determined after the Receiver performs an accounting.

## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

DUKE POWER COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing Duke Power Company, a public-utility holding company exempt from registration under Section 3(a)(2) of the Act pursuant to Rule 2, and its wholly owned indirect nonutility subsidiary company, Duke Guemes, Inc., to acquire indirectly up to a 30% ownership interest and up to a 100% operating interest in Central Termica Guemes S.A., an Argentine electric public-utility company. ## ACQUISITION OF SECURITIES

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.

Below is a list of recent filings of Schedules 13D and 14D, which includes the following information: Column 1 - the company purchased (top), and the name of the purchaser; Column 2 - the type of security purchased; Column - 3 - the type of form filed; Column 4 - the date the transaction occurred; Column 5 - the current number of shares (in 000's) owned (top) and the current percent owned; Column 6 - the CUSIP number (top) and the percent owned; and Column 7 - the status of the filing, i.e., new, update or revision.
