INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES EXCHANGE COMMO

FORTIS BENEFITS INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 28 to request a hearing on an application filed by Fortis Benefits Insurance Company, Variable Account C of Fortis Benefits Insurance Company and Fortis Investors, Inc. The application is for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act for exemptions from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 22(c), 26(a)(2)(C), 27(a)(3), 27(c)(1), 27(c)(2) and 27(d) of the Act and Rules 22c-1 and 6e-3(T)(b)(12), 6e-3(T)(b)(13) and 6e-3(T)(d)(1)(ii) thereunder. The exemptions are in connection with the offer and sale of certain flexible premium variable life insurance policies. (Rel. IC-18883 - August 7)

GENERAL SECURITIES INCORPORATED, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 1, 1992 to request a hearing on an application filed by General Securities Incorporated (Investment Company), Craig-Hallum, Inc. (Adviser), and Hamilton Investments, Inc. (Hamilton). The application is for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting an exemption from Section 15(a) to permit implementation, without shareholder approval, of a new investment advisory agreement between the Investment Company and the Adviser, as approved by the Investment Company's Board of Directors. The order would also permit the Adviser to receive, subject to shareholder approval, fees earned under the new agreement from the date of the merger between a wholly-owned subsidiary of Hamilton and the Adviser's parent corporation to the date the new investment advisory agreement is approved or disapproved by the Investment Company's shareholders, which period shall be no longer than 120 days. AIM GOVERNMENT FUNDS, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 1, 1992 to request a hearing on an application filed by AIM Government Funds, Inc. for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that applicant has ceased to be an investment company. AIM TAX-EXEMPT FUNDS, INC.

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CONSOLIDATED NATURAL GAS COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Consolidated Natural Gas Company (Consolidated), a registered holding company, and its wholly owned non-utility subsidiary company, CNG Trading Company (Trading). The order authorizes Consolidated and Trading pursuant to Section 2(b) of the Gas Related Activities Act of 1990 to remove the restriction on revenues Trading can earn from off-system, non-associated companies contained in the original Commission order authorizing the creation of Trading. (Rel. 35-25600)

MISSISSIPPI POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Mississippi Power Company (Mississippi), a wholly owned electric public-utility subsidiary company of The Southern Company, a registered holding company, to engage in financing. Mississippi proposes to issue and sell, at any time on or before June 30, 1994 one or more series of its first mortgage bonds in an aggregate principal amount of up to \$100 million (Bonds) and preferred stock in an aggregate par or stated value of up to \$50 million (Preferred). Both the Bonds and Preferred will be issued under the competitive bidding procedures of Rule 50 of the Act as modified by the Commission's Statement of Policy dated September 2, 1982 (HCAR No. 22623). The Commission shall reserve jurisdiction over all transactions in connection with the issuance and sale of one or more series of pollution control revenue bonds in an aggregate principal amount of up to \$25 million. The Commission shall also reserve jurisdiction over the issuance and sale of the Bonds and Preferred under an exception from the competitive bidding requirements of Rule 50 under subsection (a)(5). In addition, the Commission shall reserve jurisdiction over the issuance and sale of the Bonds with an adjustable interest rate and the issuance and sale of Preferred with an adjustable rate of dividend, pending completion of the record. A supplemental notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 31 to request a hearing on a proposal by Arkansas Power & Light Company (AP&L), an electric public-utility subsidiary company of Entergy Corporation, a registered holding company. AP&L proposes to issue \$35 million of preferred stock through December 31, 1993 under the exemptive provisions of Rule 52 (Remaining Stock). For the period during which any shares of the Remaining Stock are outstanding, AP&L proposes to redeem shares of its Remaining Stock, in accordance with any mandatory or optional redemption provisions established at the time of the Remaining Stock's initial issuance. Also, for the period during which any shares of the Remaining Stock are outstanding, AP&L proposes to redeem (or purchase in lieu of redemption) outstanding Remaining Stock, in accordance with the sinking fund provisions established at the time of the Remaining Stock's initial issuance. In addition, AP&L proposes to extend its period of authorization from August 31, 1992 to December 31, 1993 to acquire from time to time \$328.55 million aggregate principal amount of one or more series of AP&L's outstanding first mortgage bonds; \$175 million aggregate principal amount of one or more series of the outstanding pollution control revenue bonds and/or solid waste disposal bonds issued for AP&L's benefit; and \$150 million aggregate par value of one or more series of AP&L's outstanding preferred stock. CONSOLIDATED NATURAL GAS CO.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 31 to request a hearing on a proposal by Consolidated Natural Gas Co. (CNG), a registered holding company, CNG Energy, its wholly owned nonutility subsidiary, and the Lakewood Cogeneration, L.P. (Partnership), an affiliated limited partnership (collectively, Applicants). The Applicants request the authority to fund up to \$50 million through December 31, 1996 of a qualifying cogeneration facility (QF), under the Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act of 1978, located in Lakewood, New Jersey (Lakewood Project). The Applicants propose to channel such funding from CNG to CNG Energy, from CNG Energy to the CNG Lakewood, Inc., a to-be-formed subsidiary of CNG Energy, from CNG Lakewood, Inc. to the Partnership, and from the Partnership to the Project. The funds will be passed from entity to entity through any one or a combination of common stock acquisitions, open account advances or long-term loans. The Applicants also request that CNG, CNG Energy and CNG Lakewood, Inc. be authorized to make guarantees, obtain letters of credit and deliver keep well letters in the aggregate amount up to \$50 The Applicants also request that certain third party financing for the Lakewood Project be exempt from Section 6(a) of the Act pursuant to Section 6(b). PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 31 to request a hearing on a proposal by Public Service of New Hampshire (PSNH), an electric utility subsidiary company of Northeast Utilities, a registered public-utility holding company. PSNH proposes to replace an existing letter of credit issued by Citibank, N.A. with a substitute letter of credit issued by Barclays Bank PLC, New York Branch (Barclays). The letter of credit has been, and the Barclays letter of credit will be, used to improve the credit ratings and stabilize the remarketing of certain outstanding taxable pollution control revenue bonds.
