ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

DECISION BARRING STEVEN ERIK JOHNSTON FROM ASSOCIATION WITH ANY BROKER OR DEALER AND SUSPENDING PATRICIA ANN GRIFFITH FROM ASSOCIATION WITH ANY BROKER OR DEALER FOR THIRTY DAYS BECOMES FINAL

The decision of an administrative law judge barring Steven Erik Johnston of Fort Worth, Texas from association with any broker or dealer, and suspending Patricia Ann Griffith, also of Fort Worth, from association with any broker or dealer for thirty days has become final. Griffith's suspension is effective on August 24.

Johnston and Griffith were registered representatives in the Fort Worth office of Dean Witter Reynolds, Inc. The law judge found that from 1985 through October, 1987 Johnston and Griffith violated the antifraud provisions of the securities laws in connection with the offer and sale of naked options. According to the law judge, Johnston, among other things, effected unauthorized trades in investors' accounts and falsified records in furtherance of his scheme. The law judge further found that Griffith obtained money from investors on the basis of false representations, and failed to disclose material information. (Rel. 34-30142)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

EDWARD SCHERER AND RICHARD KURSMAN, FORMERLY OF MERRILL LYNCH, SUED

The Commission announced that on August 20 it filed a complaint against Edward L. Scherer and Richard T. Kursman, formerly employed in Merrill Lynch's high yield department, alleging violations of the Exchange Act's antifraud provisions. The complaint alleges that Scherer and Kursman, while employees of Merrill, engaged in a fraudulent scheme, generating profits of over \$1,000,000, by purchasing, without prior approval, high yield securities in nominee accounts in which Scherer and Kursman had a concealed interest at prices more favorable than would have been offered to retail customers. The complaint also alleges that Scherer purchased high yield securities while preparing a positive recommendation concerning those securities and failed to disclose his financial interest in the securities to Merrill's customers when his opinion was being disseminated.

Simultaneous with the complaint's filing, without admitting or denying the allegations, Kursman consented to the entry of a Final Judgment, which orders Kursman to pay a \$15,000 civil penalty, to cooperate with the Commission, and to forego the trading profits. Kursman has agreed to be barred from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company, or municipal securities dealer. CIVIL ACTION AGAINST NRG INTERNATIONAL, INC., ALBERT LAWSON, ROLAND UY AND MILTON TRUJILLO

The Commission announced the filing of a complaint in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of California against NRG International, Inc.; Albert E. Lawson, NRG's former President and Chairman of the Board; and Roland Uy and Milton Trujillo, NRG's former accountants. The complaint seeks to enjoin NRG and Lawson from violating Section 17(a) of the Securities Act and seeks to enjoin all defendants from violating Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder.

The complaint alleges that Lawson, Uy and Trujillo, variously, engaged in a series of fraudulent acts as part of a scheme to create a market for and increase the price of NRG common stock by, among other things, creating and disseminating to the public materially false and misleading financial information. This information was contained in NRG's purported Annual Reports on Form 10-K for the years 1986 through 1990, an NRG audit report and financial statements for the first six months of 1987 and an NRG Corporate Profile. The complaint also alleges that Lawson sold NRG stock while in possession of material non-public information.

NRG, Uy and Trujillo have consented to the entry of judgments enjoining them from violating various antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. [SEC v. CIVIL COMPLAINT REQUESTING TEMPORARY, PRELIMINARY, AND PERMANENT INJUNCTIVE RELIEF FILED AGAINST BROWN & MUELLER INVESTMENTS LTD., RONALD MARGOLIN, ROGER B. WEBB, MARK LUTZ, AND CMB CAPITAL MANAGEMENT INC.

The Commission today announced the filing of a civil injunctive action in the Southern District of New York against Brown & Mueller Investment Ltd. (BMI), Ronald Margolin (Margolin), Roger B. Webb (Webb), Mark Lutz (Lutz), and CMB Capital Management Inc. (CMB). The action seeks temporary, preliminary, and permanent injunctive relief from future violations of the antifraud and other provisions of the federal securities laws, an order freezing the defendants' assets, an accounting, disgorgement in the amount of at least \$900,000 plus prejudgment interest, and a civil penalty.

According to the complaint, BMI is a Bahamian corporation controlled by Margolin and is operating as an unlawfully unregistered broker-dealer in Pembroke Pines, Florida. CMB, according to the complaint, is a Delaware corporation controlled by Lutz. The complaint alleges that Margolin, Webb, Lutz and CMB used BMI to engage in a wide-spread free-riding scheme from September 1991 until at least April 1992 whereby the defendants traded millions of dollars worth of securities without having the intent or ability to pay for the securities. In many instances, the complaint alleges, the defendants simply walked away from unprofitable trades, leaving the brokers to absorb the defendants' losses. According to the complaint, the defendants caused their brokers losses and reaped profits totalling over \$780,000.

The complaint also alleges that Webb fraudulently obtained at least \$130,000 from investors. According to the Complaint, none of these monies have been returned to the investors. [SEC v. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NORTH AMERICAN SECURITY LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 14, 1992 to request a hearing on an application filed by North American Security Life Insurance Company (Security Life), NASL Variable Account (Variable Account), NASL Financial Services, Inc. (NASL Financial) and Wood Logan Associates Inc. (Wood Logan). The application is for an order pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of a mortality and expense risk charge from the assets of the Variable Account with respect to certain fixed and variable annuity contracts. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MAINE YANKEE ATOMIC POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Maine Yankee Atomic Power Company, an indirect subsidiary of Northeast Utilities and New England Electric System, both registered holding companies, to extend, through August 31, 1995, existing authorization under

order of the Commission dated July 18, 1989 (HCAR No. 24925) to borrow under a revolving credit agreement (Credit Agreement) in an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$50 million at any one time. Maine Yankee also proposes amendments to the Credit Agreement, which would, among other things, alter two of the four interest rate options available under the Credit Agreement and increase the bid loan fee payable to the lenders. LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES SOUGHT

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 7, 1992 to comment on the application of the <u>Midwest Stock Exchange</u> for unlisted trading privileges in an over-the-counter issue: Adaptec, Inc., and an application to withdraw unlisted trading privileges in an over-the-counter issue: T2 Medical, Inc. (Rel. 34-31050)

UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES GRANTED

Orders have been issued granting the application of four exchanges for unlisted trading privileges in issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchanges and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. The exchanges and number of issues are as follows: <u>Boston Stock Exchange</u> - 2 issues (Rel. 34-31051); <u>Cincinnati Stock Exchange</u> - 11 issues (Rel. 34-31052); <u>Midwest Stock Exchange</u> - 8 issues (Rel. 34-31053); and <u>Philadelphia Stock Exchange</u> - 22 issues (Rel. 34-31054)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved on an accelerated basis a proposed rule change (SR-CSE-92-10) filed by the <u>Cincinnati Stock Exchange</u> to extend the CSE's preferencing rule for nine months and to increase from 250 to 350 the number of stock that a Designated Dealer may preference during the pilot phase of the CSE preferencing rule. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of August 6. (Rel. 34-31011)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has approved a proposed rule change filed by the <u>New York Stock Exchange</u> (SR-NYSE-92-03) amending NYSE Rule 411(b) to require that persons entering multiple odd-lot orders for accounts in which they have investment discretion must aggregate such orders into round-lots for execution in the round-lot auction market. (Rel. 34-31048)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF AMENDMENT

The Options Pricing Authority (OPRA) submitted pursuant to Rule 11Aa3-2 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 an amendment to the Plan for Reporting of Consolidated Options Last Sale Reports and Quotation Information (Plan) for the purpose of revising certain access fees charged by OPRA. OPRA designated the proposal as establishing or changing a fee or other charge collected on behalf of all the OPRA participants in connection with access to or use of OPRA facilities, permitting it to become effective upon filing with the Commission pursuant to Rule 11Aa3-2(c)(3)(i) under the Act. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of August 24. (Rel. 34-31049)
