INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

FORTIS BENEFITS INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Fortis Benefits Insurance Company, Variable Account C of Fortis Benefits Insurance Company and Fortis Investors, Inc. from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 22(c), 26(a)(2)(C), 27(a)(3), 27(c)(1), 27(c)(2) and 27(d) of the Act and Rules 22c-1 and 6e-3(T)(b)(12), 6e-3(T)(b)(13) and 6e-3(T)(d)(1)(ii) thereunder in connection with the offer and sale of certain flexible premium variable life insurance policies. (Rel. IC-18924 - September 2)

PACIFIC CORINTHIAN LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 24 to request a hearing on an application filed by Pacific Corinthian Life Insurance Company and Pacific Corinthian VIP Separate Account of Pacific Corinthian Life Insurance Company (PCL Separate Account). The application is for an order of the Commission under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting exemptions from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c), 26(a)(2)(C), 27(c)(2) and 27(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder to permit the deduction of a mortality and expense risk charge from the assets of the PCL Separate Account under certain variable annuity contracts and the imposition of a contingent deferred sales charge under those contracts. Applicants also request exemptions under Sections 17(b) and 17(d) of the Act and Rule 17d-1 thereunder to the extent necessary to permit the transfer of assets from the Shearson VIP Separate Account of First Capital Life Insurance Company -- In Conservation (FCL Separate Account) to the PCL Separate Account. Finally, the applicants request an exemption under Section 11 of the Act to the extent necessary to permit an offer of exchange of interests in the FCL Separate Account for interests in the PCL Separate Account. (Rel. IC-18925 - September 2)

GENERAL SECURITIES, INCORPORATED, ET AL.

An order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act of exempting General Securities, Incorporated (the Investment Company), Craig-Hallum, Inc. (the Adviser) and Hamilton Investments, Inc. (Hamilton) from Section 15(a) of the Act. The order permits implementation, without shareholder approval, of a new investment advisory agreement, as approved by the Investment Company's Board of Directors. The order also permits the Adviser to receive, subject to shareholder approval, fees earned under the new agreement from the date of the merger between a wholly-owned subsidiary of Hamilton and the Adviser's parent corporation to the date the new agreement is approved or diapproved by the Investment Company's shareholders, which period shall be no longer than 120 days. (Rel. IC-18927 - September 3)

AIM GOVERNMENT FUNDS, INC.

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that AIM Government Funds, Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18928 - September 3)

AIM TAX-EXEMPT FUNDS, INC.

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that AIM Tax-Exempt Funds, Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18929 -September 3)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ENTERGY CORPORATION

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Entergy Corporation, a registered holding company. Entergy proposes to acquire through December 31, 1992 not more than 1,500 shares of the common stock of Electec, a wholly-owned nonutility subsidiary of Entergy, at \$1,000 per share for an aggregate cash consideration of \$1.5 million. (Rel. 35-25617)

SYSTEM FUELS, INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by System Fuels, Inc., a fuel supply company jointly owned by Arkansas Power & Light Company, Louisiana Power & Light Company, Mississippi Power & Light Company, and New Orleans Public Service Inc. (all companies collectively, Applicants), each an electric public utility subsidiary of Entergy Corporation, a registered holding company. The Applicants have filed a post-effective amendment to their application requesting that the effectiveness of the order of the Commission dated July 7, 1992 (HCAR No. 25576), authorizing AP&L to assume SFI's existing rights and obligations under several leases of coal railroad cars, be extended for a period of one year to September 4, 1993. (Rel. 35-25618)

ARKANSAS POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Arkansas Power & Light Company (AP&L), an electric public-utility subsidiary company of Entergy Corporation, a registered holding company, through December 31, 1993 to redeem shares of its preferred stock, in accordance with any mandatory or optional redemption provisions established at the time of the preferred stock's initial issuance. The supplemental order also authorizes AP&L to redeem or purchase in lieu of redemption outstanding preferred stock, in accordance with the sinking fund provisions established at the time of the preferred stock's initial issuance. In addition, AP&L has been authorized through December 31, 1993 to acquire from time-to-time \$328.55 million aggregate principal amount of one or more series of the pollution control revenue bonds and/or solid waste disposal bonds issued for AP&L's benefit; and \$150 million aggregate par value of one or more series of AP&L preferred stocks. (Rel.35-25619)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

On June 24, 1992, the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-92-29) under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Act). The proposed rule change would amend Article III of the NASD's Rules of Fair Practice to require general securities members to send periodic account statements at least once every quarter to customers having securities positions, funds or any change in their account from the time the previous statement was sent. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of September 1. (Rel. 34-31131)

The Participants Trust Company has filed a notice of a proposed rule change (SR-PTC-92-11) under Securities Exchange Act Rule 19b-4 relating to the elimination of pennies from the face amount of certain GNMAs. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of September 7. (Rel. 34-31135)
