NOTICE OF COMMISSION MEETINGS

Following is a schedule of Commission meetings which will be conducted under provisions of the Government in the Sunshine Act. In general, the Commission expects to follow a schedule of holding closed meetings on Tuesdays, and open meetings on Thursday mornings. Meetings on Wednesdays, and if necessary on Thursday afternoons, will be either open or closed according to the requirements of agenda items under consideration.

The subject matter of the November 19 open meeting will be:

- d. Consideration of whether to adopt amendments to Form N-2, the registration form used by closed-end management investment companies under the Investment Company Act of 1940 and the Securities Act of 1933, and related rules. The amendments would shorten and simplify the prospectus provided to investors by adopting the two-part disclosure format used by mutual funds and update disclosure standards for closed-end investment companies, including companies electing to be regulated as business development companies. An amendment to Rule 8b-16 under the 1940 Act also would exempt closed-end funds from the requirement to update their 1940 Act registration statements annually, provided certain disclosures are made to fund shareholders annually. The Commission is also publishing staff guidelines for the preparation of Form N-2. FOR FURTHER INFORMATION CONTACT: Courtney Thornton at (202) 272-2097.
- 2. Consideration of whether to adopt Rule 3a-7 under the Investment Company Act of 1940 (Act). Rule 3a-7 conditionally excludes certain issuers that pool income-producing assets and issue securities backed by those assets from the definition of investment company under the Act. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NORTH AMERICAN SECURITY TRUST, ET AL.

A conditional order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting North American Security Trust, et al. from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c), and 22(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder. The exemptions apply to the extent necessary to permit the applicants to impose a contingent deferred sales charge (CDSC) on certain redemptions of shares and to waive the CDSC under certain circumstances. DREYFUS STRATEGIC WORLD REVENUES, L.P.

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that Dreyfus Strategic World Revenues, L.P. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-19093 - November 10)

FIRST PHILIPPINE FUND, INC.

A conditional order has been issued under Section 10(f) of the Investment Company Act on an application filed by First Philippine Fund, Inc. The order permits applicant to purchase Philippine securities during the existence of an underwriting syndicate in which an affiliated person of applicant's subadviser and one of its directors is a principal underwriter. THE FRANCE GROWTH FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 8, 1992 to request a hearing on an application filed by The France Growth Fund, Inc. (Fund) for an order granting an exemption from Section 10(f) of the Act. The exemption would permit the Fund to purchase securities in underwritten public offerings in the Republic of France in which Banque Indosuez, a French commercial bank and affiliated person of the Fund's investment adviser, participates as a principal underwriter. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PSI RESOURCES, INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing PSI Resources, Inc., an Indiana public-utility holding company exempt from registration under Section 3(a)(1) of the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935 pursuant to Rule 2, to acquire indirectly up to a 6% interest in an Argentine electric public-utility company and granting related exemptions to certain subsidiary companies. MISSISSIPPI POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued releasing jurisdiction over a proposal by Mississippi Power & Light Company (MP&L), an electric public-utility subsidiary company of Entergy Corporation, a registered holding company. MP&L proposes to issue and sell \$65 million aggregate principal amount of two new series of general and refunding mortgage bonds (Bonds) by means of private placement. Jurisdiction will continue to be reserved over MP&L's proposal to issue and sell not more than \$85 million aggregate principal amount of one or more new series of general and refunding mortgage bonds through competitive bidding, negotiated public offering or private Jurisdiction will also continue to be reserved over MP&L's proposal to issue and sell not more than \$37.5 million of preferred stock, cumulative, \$100 par value, in one or more new series by negotiated public offering or private placement and the granting of an exception from the competitive bidding requirements of Rule In addition, jurisdiction will continue to be reserved over MP&L's proposal to arrange for the issuance of not more than \$25 million aggregate principal amount of tax-exempt bonds for the benefit of MP&L and amend MP&L's Restated Articles of Incorporation, as amended, to establish a new class of preferred stock having no par value or a nominal par value.
