### ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED, FINDINGS MADE AND SANCTIONS IMPOSED AGAINST KENNETH FLETCHER

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings, made findings and imposed remedial sanctions against Kenneth D. Fletcher (Fletcher) of Fort Lauderdale, Florida. Fletcher was the former president of CommVest Securities, Inc., a registered broker-dealer that was a wholly-owned subsidiary of Commonwealth Savings and Loan Association of Florida.

The Commission accepted an Offer of Settlement by Fletcher in which he consented to the entry of an Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions containing findings that Fletcher was convicted on April 24, 1991 of one count of conspiracy to commit bank fraud, wire fraud, misapplication of savings and loan monies and making false entries in savings and loan records in violation of 18 U.S.C. Sections 2 and 371, and one count of bank fraud in violation of 18 U.S.C. Sections 2 and 1344. (Rel. 34-31589)

### PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST RICHARD SOL ROSEN

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Richard Sol Rosen (Rosen). The Order alleges that Rosen, a former registered representative of a broker-dealer registered with the Commission, violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 by falsely stating to investors that the investors' funds would be used for investment purposes, when, in fact, Rosen was misappropriating the funds.

Simultaneously with the institution of these proceedings, Rosen has submitted an Offer of Settlement which the Commission has accepted. Rosen consented to an Order which bars him from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company. (Rel. 34-31590)

### INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

AMERICAN SKANDIA LIFE ASSURANCE CORPORATION, ET AL.

An order has been issued to American Skandia Life Assurance Corporation (ASLAC), American Skandia Life Assurance Corporation Variable Account B, American Skandia Trust and Skandia Life Equity Sales Corporation pursuant to Section 26(b) of the Investment Company Act. The order approves the substitution of shares of the American Skandia Trust Money Market Portfolio for shares of the Alger American Money Market Portfolio and the Neuberger & Berman Advisers Management Trust Liquid Asset Portfolio to fund certain flexible purchase payment deferred variable annuity contracts issued by ASLAC. Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
