RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

CORRECTION TO INTERIM RULES FOR EDGAR SYSTEM

The Commission released today corrections to the interim rules that were originally published Thursday, March 18, 1993 (58 FR 14628). The interim rules relate to the implementation of the Commission's Electronic Data Gathering, Analysis and Retrieval (EDGAR) system.

These rules are effective as of April 26, 1993, except entry number 27 in the Exhibit Tables to Item 601 of Regulations S-K and Regulation S-B, relating to the Financial Data Schedule, which will be effective on November 1, 1993. ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

GREGORY MAXCY SANCTIONED

The Commission has issued an Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions against Gregory Maxcy. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted an Offer of Settlement from Maxcy under which he consented, without admitting or denying, to the findings contained in the Commission's Order. Additionally, Maxcy consented to being barred from the securities industry with the right to reapply after five years.

On the basis of the Order and the Offer of Settlement, the Commission found that between 1985 and March 1986, Maxcy fraudulently sold unregistered shares of the preferred stock of Equity Management Associates (EMA). The Order further found that Maxcy misrepresented or omitted statements of material facts, concerning among other things, EMA's financial condition, related party transactions, use of offering proceeds and the degree of risk and profitability of the investment. Maxcy was an officer and director of EMA. (Rel. 34-32245)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

EMPIRE FIDELITY INVESTMENTS LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Empire Fidelity Investments Life Insurance Company, Empire Fidelity Investments Variable Annuity Account A (Variable Account), and Fidelity Brokerage Services, Inc. from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act. The exemptions apply to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of a mortality and expense risk charge from the assets of the Variable Account under certain variable annuity contracts. (Rel. DEFINED ASSET FUNDS -- EQUITY INCOME FUND, SELECT TEN PORTFOLIO (1993 WINTER SERIES)

A conditional order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Defined Asset Funds--Equity Income Fund, Select Ten Portfolio (1993 Winter Series) and subsequent series from Section 12(d)(3) of the Act. The exemptions apply to the extent necessary to permit each series to invest up to ten percent of its total assets in securities of issuers that derived more than fifteen percent of their gross revenues in their most recent fiscal year from securities related activities. DEAN WITTER AMERICAN VALUE FUND. ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 1, 1993 to request a hearing on an application filed by Dean Witter American Value Fund, et al. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act. Applicants seek to amend certain prior orders that granted exemptive relief to assess and waive a contingent deferred sales charge (CDSC). The amended order would permit applicants to waive the CDSC in connection with certain additional types of redemptions. (Rel. IC-19457 - May 5)

AMERICAN INVESTORS GROWTH FUND, INC. AMERICAN INVESTORS MONEY FUND, INC. AMERICAN INVESTORS INCOME FUND, INC.

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until June 1, 1993 to request a hearing on applications filed by AMERICAN INVESTORS GROWTH FUND, INC., AMERICAN INVESTORS MONEY FUND, INC. and AMERICAN INVESTORS INCOME FUND, INC. for orders under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that they have ceased to be investment companies. GREAT HALL INVESTMENT FUNDS, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 1, 1993 to request a hearing on an application filed by Great Hall Investment Funds, Inc., et al. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act that would grant an exemption from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c), and 22(d) of the Act, and Rule 22c-1 thereunder. The order would permit certain investment companies to impose and, under certain circumstances, waive a contingent deferred sales charge on certain redemptions of their shares. (Rel. APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-93-7) filed by the <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> which amends Section 3(f) to Part II of Schedule D to the NASD By-Laws to require a Nasdaq SmallCap issuer to comply with all applicable requirements for initial inclusion under Part II to Schedule D and to require a Nasdaq/NMS issuer to comply with all applicable requirements for initial inclusion under Parts II and III to Schedule D in the event that the Nasdaq System issuer enters into a merger, consolidation or other type of acquisition with a non-Nasdaq System entity which results in a change in control and either a change in business or change in the financial structure of the Nasdaq SmallCap or Nasdaq/NMS issuer. ACQUISITION OF SECURITIES

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
