COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

RVEY OF FINANCIAL STATEMENT RECONCILIATIONS BY FOREIGN REGISTRANTS PUBLICLY AVAILABLE

The Commission has made publicly available a staff report entitled "Survey of Financial Statement Reconciliations by Foreign Registrants." The report surveys the frequency, size and general nature of reconciling items disclosed by foreign companies in SEC filings. Copies may be obtained from the Commission's Public Reference Room.

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

MPLAINT FILED AGAINST FERDINAND RUSSO, ET AL.

On May 11, the Commission filed a complaint in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York against Ferdinand Russo, Russo Securities, Inc., Lawrence A. Mascera and Mascera & Company, Inc. seeking injunctive relief and civil penalties. The complaint alleges that the defendants aided and abetted violations of Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder.

The complaint alleges that the defendants aided and abetted a scheme by The Cooper Companies, Inc. (Cooper), a New York Stock Exchange listed company, and its former Co-Chairman of the Board of Directors, Gary Alan Singer, to avoid a June 15, 1991 interest rate reset on Cooper's 10 5/8% Convertible Subordinated Reset Debentures, due 2005, by issuing sham opinion letters to the effect that no interest rate reset was necessary on the Debentures. CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

STEVEN WYMER SENTENCED

The Commission and the U.S. Attorney for the Central District of California announced that on May 11 the Honorable Richard A. Gadbois, U.S. District Judge for the Central District of California, sentenced Steven D. Wymer (Wymer) to 14 years and 7 months in prison and ordered Wymer to pay \$91,732,000 in restitution to his defrauded clients. On September 29, 1992, Wymer pleaded guilty to nine felony counts of racketeering, securities fraud, mail fraud, bank fraud and obstruction of justice, and, in the Commission's civil action, was ordered to pay approximately \$209 million in restitution and prejudgment interest to his defrauded advisory clients (LR-13389)

From 1987 through 1991, Wymer, through two investment advisers owned and operated by him, Institutional Treasury Management, Inc. and its predecessor, Denman & Company (jointly, ITM), conducted a massive fraudulent scheme against his advisory clients principally small cities and towns, local government agencies and financial institutions. Wymer misappropriated and diverted his advisory clients' funds commingling and using the funds to pay purported profits on non-existent securities transactions made on behalf of his clients, to cover client and personal tradim losses, to fund ITM's operations and to pay for Wymer's lavish personal living expenses. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

COLONIAL GOVERNMENT SECURITIES PLUS TRUST COLONIAL STRATEGIC INCOME TRUST COLONIAL CORPORATE CASH TRUST I COLONIAL TAX-EXEMPT MONEY MARKET TRUST THE COLONIAL FUND

Orders have been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that the above-named companies have ceased to be investment companies. (Rels. 19465; IC-19466; IC-19467; IC-19468; and IC-19469, respectively - May 11)

THE ONE GROUP AND GOLDMAN, SACHS & CO.

An order has been issued on an application filed by THE ONE GROUP (formerly, The Helmsman Fund) (Fund) and Goldman, Sachs & Co. (Goldman Sachs) under Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicants from Section 17(a). The order permits portfolios of the Fund to engage in principal transactions with Goldman Sachs and any other securities dealer that may be an affiliated person of an affiliated person of such portfolios solely because of sub-advisory relationships with other portfolios of the Fund. The order also permits Goldman Sachs to engage in principal transactions with portfolios of any registered investment company of which Goldman Sachs is an affiliated person of an affiliated person solely because of its sub-advisory relationship with other portfolios of that investment company. (Rel. IC-19470 - May 11)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ALABAMA POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Alabama Power Company, an electric publicutility subsidiary company of The Southern Company, a registered holding company, to refinance \$96.990 million of the costs of certain pollution control and sewage and solid waste disposal facilities located in various Alabama cities. The Commission has reserved jurisdiction over all transactions associated with refinancing additional costs for such facilities in amounts of up to \$353.010 million. (Rel. 35-25809)

LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES GRANTED

Orders have been issued granting the applications of two exchanges for unlisted trading privileges in issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchange and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. The exchanges and number of issues are as follows: Midwest Stock Exchange - 2 issues (Rel. 34-32286); and Cincinnati Stock Exchange - 20 issues (Rel. 34-32287).

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-9: 22) filed by the New York Stock Exchange to extend Rule 103A - Specialist Stock Reallocation - until May 9, 1994. (Rel. 34-32285)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> filed a proposed rule change (S NASD-93-30) changing from 59% to 62% the credit each NASD member shall receive during calendar year 1993 against the member's annual assessment on gross income. Because this proposed rule change constitutes a stated policy, practice, or interpretation with respect to the meaning, administration, or enforcement of an existing rule undescription 19(b)(3)(A)(ii) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, it became effecting upon the Commission's receipt of this filing on May 4, 1993. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of May 10. (Rel. 36 32289)
