EXCHANGE COMMISSION

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

JOHN ARNOLD ENJOINED

The Commission announced that on March 5, 1993 the Honorable William L. Beatty, United States District Court Judge for the Southern District of Illinois entered an Order of Permanent Injunction, by consent, against Defendant John E. Arnold enjoining him from future violations of the antifraud and broker-dealer registration provisions of the federal securities laws. The issue of whether to impose civil penalties on Arnold will be determined by the Court at a later date.

The Commission's complaint alleged that from about October 1990 through October 1991, while employed as a registered representative by Independent Financial Securities, Inc., a registered broker-dealer, Arnold misappropriated for personal use in excess of \$200,000 from the accounts of at least seven of his customers. The complaint further alleged that Arnold diverted to himself in excess of \$38,000 in commission income by conducting approximately \$1,300,000 worth of private securities transactions through E.C.I. Investments, an entity wholly owned by Arnold that was not registered with the Commission as a broker-dealer.

On March 31, 1992, in a prior criminal action relating to the same conduct, Arnold was sentenced to 27 months imprisonment and ordered to make restitution of approximately \$250,000. [SEC v. Arnold, USDC, SD Ill., Civil Action No. 92-657-WLB] (LR-13671)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ZAPATA CORPORATION

An order has been issued under Section 3(b)(2) of the Investment Company Act granting Zapata Corporation a temporary exemption from all provisions of the Act. On April 16, 1993, Zapata filed an application for an order under Section 3(b)(2) declaring that it is not an investment company or, alternatively, an order under Section 6(c)exempting it from all provisions of the Act. Zapata also sought a temporary order under Section 3(b)(2) or Section 6(c) extending the sixty day automatic exemption provided by Section 3(b)(2) upon the filing of an application in good faith, to permit the Commission to make a final determination upon the request for a permanent order. The temporary order will expire ninety days from the date of its issuance. Prior to the issuance of a permanent order to Zapata, if any, the Commission will issue a notice giving interested persons an opportunity to request a hearing. (Rel. IC-19524 - June 14)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC., ET AL.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by The Columbia Gas System, Inc. (Columbia), a registered holding company, and Columbia LNG Corporation (Columbia LNG), its nonutility subsidiary company. Columbia is authorized to increase the maximum amount of short-term revolving advances to Columbia LNG through September 30, 1993 by \$2.45 million. (Rel. 35-25823)

AMERICAN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 6, 1993 to request a hearing on a proposal by American Electric Power Company, Inc. (AEP), a registered holding company, and American Electric Power Service Corporation (AEPSC), AEP's subsidiary service company. AEPSC proposes to issue and sell from time to time through December 31, 1996 promissory notes in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$25 million outstanding at any one time. In order to induce a lender to purchase such notes from AEPSC, AEP proposes to unconditionally guarantee payment to such lender the amounts due and unpaid by AEPSC. (Rel. 35-25824)

THE COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC.

A supplemental order has issued authorizing The Columbia Gas System, Inc., a registered holding company and a debtor in possession under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code, to amend the terms of a previously authorized secured revolving credit agreement by reducing the maximum amount outstanding to \$100 million and extending its term to December 31, 1994. LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

DELISTING GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the <u>New York Stock Exchange</u> to strike from listing and registration MAI Systems Corporation, Common Stock, \$.01 Par Value. (Rel. 34-32456)

UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES SOUGHT

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 6, 1993 to comment on the application of the <u>Midwest Stock Exchange</u> for unlisted trading privileges in one over-the-counter issue and an application to withdraw unlisted trading privileges in one over-the-counter issue. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>Chicago Board Options Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-93-21) relating to the listing and trading of European-style, yield-based, cash-settled options on long-term Treasury bonds and notes of specified maturities. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 14. (Rel. 34-32451)

PARTIAL ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>Philadelphia Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-PHLX-93-02) relating to Friday expiration dates for foreign currency options. Partial accelerated approval was granted by the Commission for the purpose of allowing the Exchange to list longterm foreign currency options expiring in June, 1995, with Friday expirations. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 14. (Rel. 34-32452)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by <u>The Options Clearing</u> <u>Corporation</u> (SR-OCC-93-01) that allows OCC's Board of Directors greater flexibility in scheduling regular Board meetings. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 14. (Rel. 34-32454)

The Commission approved proposed rule changes filed by the <u>American Stock Exchange</u>, <u>Boston Stock Exchange</u>, <u>Midwest Stock Exchange</u>, <u>National Association of Securities</u> <u>Dealers</u>, <u>New York Stock Exchange</u>, <u>Pacific Stock Exchange</u> and <u>Philadelphia Stock</u> <u>Exchange</u> (SR-Amex-93-07; SR-BSE-93-08; SR-MSE-93-03; SR-NASD-93-11; SR-NYSE-93-13; SR-PSE-93-04; and SR-Phlx-93-09, respectively). The proposed rule changes require, subject to certain exceptions set forth in the text of the rule, book-entry settlement of transactions between member firms and between member firms and their institutional clients where settlement is effected on a delivery-versus-payment or receipt-versuspayment basis. The rule changes take effect sixty day following Commission approval. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 14. (Re1. 34-32455)

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
