COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

EDGAR PHASE-IN LIST UPDATES AVAILABLE TO PUBLIC

Pursuant to Rule 901 of Regulation S-T, registrants whose filings are processed by the Division of Corporation Finance may request a change in the date they become subject to mandated electronic filing on the Electronic Data Gathering, Analysis, and Retrieval (EDGAR) system. The Division intends to publish from time to time changes and corrections to the phase-in list published in the <u>Federal Register</u> on March 18, 1993 (Rel. 33-6977, February 23, 1993, 58 FR 14628). A change to a company's phase-in date is of particular importance to persons or entities filing documents with respect to that company, since generally such persons must file electronically when the company become subject to electronic filing.

The updates will be published in the SEC News Digest and copies of the phase-in list updates will be available through the Commission's public reference room. They also will be posted on the EDGAR electronic bulletin board.

In addition, the Division has placed in the public reference room a copy of the phase-in list as of February 23, 1993, with companies sorted by group number. This information was published in the <u>Federal Register</u> on March 18, 1993, with all companies being listed in alphabetical order rather than sorted by group number.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS AGAINST DONALD HINKLE AND JUDITH KONRATH

The Commission announced the institution of administrative proceedings pursuant to Rule 2(e) of the Commission's Rules of Practice against Donald D. Hinkle (Hinkle) and Judith A. Konrath (Konrath), certified public accountants, based upon improper professional conduct. The Commission accepted their offers of settlement, to be denied the privilege of appearing or practicing before the Commission for a period of three years. (Rel. 34-32453; AAE Rel. 453)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

LEXINGTON TECHNICAL STRATEGY FUND, INC.

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that Lexington Technical Strategy Fund, Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-19525 - June 17)

AFFILIATED FUND, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 12, 1993 to request a hearing on an application filed by Affiliated Fund, Inc., et al. for a conditional, amended order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicants from Sections 13(a)(2), 18(f)(1), 22(f), and 22(g), and under Section 17(d) and Rule 17d-1 thereunder. The order would permit certain registered open-end investment companies to offered deferred compensation arrangements to their directors and trustees who are not interested persons of such companies within the meaning of Section 2(a)(19). (Rel. IC-19526 - June 17)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF OKLAHOMA

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Public Service Company of Oklahoma (PSC-OK), an electric public-utility subsidiary company of Central and South West Corporation, a registered holding company. PSC-OK proposes to sell to Ruffin Properties (Buyer), an electric customer of PSC-OK and a nonassociate company, for an aggregate sales price of \$221,517 certain transformation facilities (Facilities) located on the Buyer's property. The Facilities consist of five three phase, 13.2 kv/480-277 volt step-down transformers and associated equipment and facilities. (Rel. 35-25827)

THE CONNECTICUT LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by The Connecticut Light and Power Company (CL&P), a public-utility subsidiary company of Northeast Utilities, a registered holding company. CL&P proposes to make monthly advances through March 31, 1995, in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$12 million outstanding at any one time, to Great Bay Power Corporation (formerly known as EUA Power Corporation). The United Illuminating Company, an exempt public utility holding company, will also make advances up to \$8 million. (Rel. 35-25828)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-93-25) to permit more rapid inclusion in the OTC Bulletin Board Service of equity securities being delisted either from the New York or American Stock Exchanges for non-compliance with exchange maintenance-of-listing standards. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 21. (Rel. 34-32477)

The <u>Chicago Board of Options Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-93-18) to eliminate the minimum net liquidating equity requirement for floor brokers. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 21. (Rel. 34-32478)

The <u>Midwest Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-MSE-93-10) to establish the MSE's SuperMAX system on a permanent basis and to amend the current SuperMAX "fill-size" parameters for eligible issues by establishing a two-tiered system for SuperMAX fills. The SuperMAX program provides that the guaranteed execution price of small agency market orders received over the Midwest Automated Execution System (MAX) are automatically improved according to certain pre-defined criteria. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 21. (Rel. 34-32484)

The <u>Pacific Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-PSE-93-07) to permit the Exchange to list and trade quarterly index expiration (QIX) options based on the Wilshire Small Cap Index. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 21. (Rel. 34-32485)

The <u>New York Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-93-21) to streamline its listing procedures for debt securities. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 21. (Rel. 34-32486)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The <u>Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-MSRB-93-8), which became effective upon filing, to establish prices for backlog document collections relating to its Official Statement/Advance Refunding Document subsystem of the Municipal Securities Information Library system. The proposed fees are structured to defray the Board's dissemination costs. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 21. (Rel. 34-32482)

The <u>Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-MSRB-93-7), which became effective upon filing, to accelerate the implementation of the second phase of its Continuing Disclosure Information Pilot system in order to accept disclosure notices from issuers. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 21. (Rel. 34-32483)

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
