SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-93-34) that amends Article IX, Section 4 of the NASD By-Laws to conform the procedures for filing vacancies on Nominating Committees to those currently in place for District Committees. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of June 28. (Rel. 34-32516)

The Options Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-OCC-93-13) to expand the cross-margining program between OCC and the Kansas City Board of Trade Clearing Corporation to include non-proprietary positions.
