#### RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

#### EXTENSION OF PHASE-IN PERIOD FOR NEW RULE 16b-3

The Commission has issued a release extending the phase-in period for compliance with the substantive conditions of new Rule 16b-3 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 from September 1, 1993 to September 1, 1994, or such earlier date as set in further rulemaking under Section 16. #### ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

#### JAMES BURTON

The Commission instituted public proceedings against James Burton, formerly a partner with KMPG Peat Marwick and the engagement partner in charge of the audit of ABQ Corporation's financial statements for it fiscal year 1988, pursuant to Rule 2(e) of the Commission's Rules of Practice. Simultaneously, Burton submitted an Offer of Settlement consenting to the issuance of the Commission's order and a censure. The Commission's order finds that Burton did not exercise due professional care, as required by generally accepted auditing standards, in connection with his audit of certain transactions and investments by ABQ Corporation, which resulted in ABQ Corporation's material overstatement of revenue and income for fiscal year 1988 (Rel. 34-32566).

Simultaneous with the institution of these proceedings, the Commission instituted proceedings against Charles A. Haegelin, the former President of ABQ Development Corporation, and Keith Heise, the former Chief Accounting Officer of ABQ and former Chief Financial Officer of ABQ Bank, pursuant to Section 21C of the Securities and Exchange Act of 1934. #### CHARLES HAEGELIN AND KEITH HEISE

The Commission instituted public proceedings against Charles A. Haegelin, formerly the President of ABQ Development Corporation, and Keith Heise, formerly the Chief Accounting Officer of ABQ Corporation and Chief Financial Officer of ABQ Bank, pursuant to Section 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Simultaneously, Haegelin and Heise each submitted an Offer of Settlement consenting to the issuance of an order ordering Haegelin and Heise to permanently cease and desist from violating, or committing or causing any violations of, and any future violation of Sections 13(a) and 13(b)(2)(A) of the Exchange Act and Rules 12b-20, 13a-1, 13a-13 and 13b2-1 promulgated thereunder. The Commission's order finds that Haegelin and Heise caused ABQ's material overstatement of revenue and income for fiscal year 1988 and of certain quarters in 1988 and 1989 (Rel. 34-32565).

Simultaneous with the institution of these proceedings, the Commission instituted proceedings against James Burton, formerly the engagement partner responsible for ABQ Corporation's fiscal year 1988 audit, pursuant to Rule 2(e) of the Commission's Rules of Practice. (Rel. 34-32566)

# HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CONSOLIDATED NATURAL GAS CO., ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing proposal by Consolidated Natural Gas Company (CNG) and its wholly owned subsidiaries, CNG Research Company; CNG Energy Company; CNG Storage Service Company; CNG Gas Services Corporation; Consolidated Natural Gas

Service Company, Inc.; Consolidated System LNG Company (LNG); CNG Coal Company; CNG Producing Company (Producing), and its subsidiary company, CNG Pipeline Company (Pipeline); CNG Transmission Corporation; and Consolidated's public-utility subsidiary companies, The Peoples Natural Gas Company; The East Ohio Gas Company; The River Gas Company; Virginia Natural Gas, Inc.; Hope Gas, Inc.; and West Ohio Gas Company (collectively, Subsidiaries). CNG is authorized, through June 30, 1994, to issue \$800 million in short-term commercial paper; enter into back-up lines of credit up to \$600 million; and make up to \$1.26 billion in open account advances, long-term loans to, and/or capital stock purchases from, its Subsidiaries. In addition, the Subsidiaries are authorized to increase their authorized common stock. Producing is authorized to make up to \$1 million in open account advances and/or long-term loans to, and/or purchases of common stock from, Pipeline. Finally, LNG is authorized to engage in a one for one hundred reverse stock split. (Rel. 35-25841)

#### NORTHEAST UTILITIES

An order has been issued authorizing Northeast Utilities (NU), a registered holding company, and its subsidiary service company, Northeast Utilities Service Company, to acquire, issue and sell, from time to time prior to May 1, 2002, up to 15,000 shares of NU's common stock. (Rel. 35-25842)

#### SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

#### ACCELERATED APPROVAL TO AMENDMENT AND APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-Amex-93-12) filed by the American Stock Exchange which expands the Amex's Post Execution Reporting (PER) system to permit the entry of up to 25,000 shares for eligible market and limit orders for designated Unit Investment Trust Securities. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of July 5. (Rel. 34-32544)

#### ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved on an accelerated basis a proposed rule change (SR-PHLX-93-25) filed by the <u>Philadelphia Stock Exchange</u> relating to the trading hours for British pound and British pound/German mark cross-rate foreign currency option contracts. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of July 5. (Rel. 34-32545)

The Commission approved on an accelerated basis a proposed rule change (SR-PHLX-93-22) filed by the <u>Philadelphia Stock Exchange</u> relating to the trading hours for foreign currency options on Independence Day, Labor Day and Boxing Day, 1993. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of July 5. (Rel. 34-32546)

The Commission approved on an accelerated basis a proposed rule changes (SR-MCC-93-02; SR-NSCC-93-04; and SR-SCCP-93-02) filed by the <u>National Securities Clearing Corporation</u>, <u>Midwest Clearing Corporation</u> and <u>Stock Clearing Corporation</u> of <u>Philadelphia</u>, respectively. The rule changes authorize the continuance through June 30, 1994 of MCC's, NSCC's and SCCP's procedures that guarantee the settlement of participant trades at an earlier date in their Continuous Net Settlement systems and use certain revised clearing fund calculations to protect against any increased risk caused by such earlier guarantees. (Rel. 34-32547)

The Commission approved through June 30, 1994, on an accelerated basis, a proposed rule change (SR-NSCC-93-5) filed by the <u>National Securities Clearing Corporation</u> that limits the use of letters of credit of collateralize Clearing Fund obligations. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of July 5. (Rel. 34-32551)

The Commission approved on an accelerated basis a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-93-13) filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange which extends until December 31, 1993, a pilot program that allows approved public customers with qualified portfolios to effect and maintain in cash accounts debit put spread transactions in broad-based index options with European-style exercise. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of July 5. (Rel. 34-32556)

The Commission approved on an accelerated basis Amendment No. 1 to a proposed rule change (SR-PSE-92-37) filed by the <u>Pacific Stock Exchange</u> which extends the PSE's automated options trading system pilot program, called POETS, through July 31, 1993. The proposed rule change seeks permanent approval of POETS. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of July 5. (Rel. 34-32558)

The Commission approved on an accelerated basis a proposed rule change (SR-Phlx-93-03) filed by the <u>Philadelphia Stock Exchange</u> to extend the Phlx's Automated Options Market (AUTOM) system pilot program, which is an electronic delivery system of small options orders to the Phlx trading floor, until December 31, 1993. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of July 5. (Rel. 34-32559)

## APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-Amex-92-24) filed by the <u>American Stock Exchange</u> relating to cabinet trading of certain equity and derivative securities. (Rel. 34-32548)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-PSE-91-15) filed by the <u>Pacific Stock Exchange</u> (SR-PSE-91-15) relating to the administration of its own proficiency examinations for prospective equity and options floor members. (Rel. 34-32550)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-93-20) filed by the <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> that would require the use of a special indicator for average-price and other special formula trades. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of July 5. (Rel. 34-32553)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-PSE-92-45) filed by the <u>Pacific Stock Exchange</u> that increases the position and exercise limits for options on the Wilshire Small Cap Index. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of July 5. (Rel. 34-32554)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-BSE-93-9) filed by the <u>Boston Stock</u> <u>Exchange</u> that changes the date of its annual meeting and its annual election from the last Monday in September to the last Monday in November. (Rel. 34-32563)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-ISCC-93-1) filed by the <u>International Securities Clearing Corporation</u> that would establish a data transmission link with Euroclear. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of July 5. (Rel. 34-32564; International Series Rel. 560)

#### PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The <u>Boston Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change to initiate a six-month pilot program to permit competing specialists on the floor of the Exchange. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of July 5. (Rel. 34-32549)

The <u>Philadelphia Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-Phlx-92-30) to require that clearing agents take reasonable steps to ensure that only positions in Phlx-listed options that qualify for good faith margin treatment are carried in the account of a Phlx specialist or registered options trader. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of July 5. (Rel. 34-32557)
