PENNY STOCK DEFINITION FOR PURPOSES OF THE BLANK CHECK RULE

The Commission has published a release which contains a proposal for public comment which would revise the definition of "penny stock" for purposes of its rules relating to registration statements filed by blank check companies under the Securities Act of 1933. The proposed revision would make the exclusion from the penny stock definition for securities priced at five dollars or more inapplicable to securities offerings subject to Section 7(b) of the Securities Act and Rule 419 thereunder. PENNY STOCK SALES PRACTICE AND DISCLOSURE RULES

The Commission today published a release adopting previously proposed amendments to Rule 15c2-6 under the Exchange Act to make the rule generally consistent with Rules 3a51-1 and 15g-1 and to redesignate Rule 15c2-6 as Rule 15g-9. Rule 15g-2 and Schedule 15G under the Exchange Act also have been amended to require broker-dealers to obtain, prior to effecting any transaction in a penny stock, a written acknowledgement from the customer that he or she has received the risk disclosure document required by Rule 15g-2. The amendments to Rule 15c2-6 and Rule 15g-2 under the Exchange Act become effective thirty days following publication in the <u>Federal</u> <u>Register</u>. # ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

THOMAS CURTIN AND JAMES LUKENDA CENSURED BY THE COMMISSION

Thomas V. Curtin and James M. Lukenda, a partner and principle with Arthur Andersen & Co., have consented to be censured by the Commission pursuant to Rule 2(e) of the

Commissions's Rules of Practice. Curtin was the partner and Lukenda the manager on the 1987 audit of CapitalBanc Corporation. The Commission's Opinion and Order found that Curtin and Lukenda failed to exercise due professional care and failed to obtain competent evidential matter to corroborate management representations concerning CapitalBanc's cash balances. The Commission found that the auditors should have performed additional audit procedures to ascertain whether there were errors or irregularities that caused a material misstatement of the financial statements. ### SETTLEMENT OFFER OF MARK GREENWAY ACCEPTED

The Commission announced the acceptance of Mark S. Greenway's (Greenway) Offer of Settlement and the entry of an Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions.

Greenway consented to the issuance of the Order without admitting or denying the Commission's findings. The Order contains findings that from approximately June 1987 through November 1990, Greenway, while a registered representative, engaged in unauthorized margin trading in his customers' accounts. In addition, the Order contains findings that Greenway engaged in unsuitable and excessive trading in his customers' accounts and that Greenway made misrepresentations of material facts to customers regarding, among other things, the profitability of their accounts. The Order also contains findings that Greenway placed or directed the placement of false signatures on documents and false information on the books and records of a brokerdealer. According to the findings, by virtue of that conduct, Greenway willfully violated the antifraud and books and records provisions of the federal securities laws.

The Commission's Order permanently bars Greenway from association with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser or municipal securities dealer. (Rel. 34-32543)

COMMISSION REVERSES NASD DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDING AGAINST DATEK SECURITIES CORPORATION AND SHELDON MASCHLER

The Commission has set aside a disciplinary proceeding the NASD brought against Datek Securities Corporation, of Brooklyn, New York, and Sheldon Maschler, the senior trader at Datek's Staten Island, New York office. The NASD had brought an expedited remedial proceeding against Datek and Maschler in which it alleged that Datek, through Maschler, engaged in the splitting of orders on the Small Order Execution System (SOES), and that, when the orders were aggregated, they exceeded the maximum number of shares permitted on SOES. It imposed sanctions that included the suspension of Maschler and Datek's Staten Island office for six months, and the suspension of Datek from transactions in any NASD execution facility for six months.

The Commission found that two of the three members of the hearing panel that initially heard the proceeding were employed by market making firms that were the contra parties in some of the transactions at issue in the proceeding. Noting its concern with this significant conflict of interest, the Commission reversed the NASD's decision. (Rel. 34-32560)

## CEASE AND DESIST ORDER ENTERED AGAINST THE BANK OF CALIFORNIA, N.A.

The Commission announced the institution of an Order Instituting Proceedings Pursuant to Section 9(f) of the Investment Company Act of 1940 and Findings and Order against The Bank of California, N.A. (Bank). The Order requires the Bank to permanently cease and desist from committing or causing any violations and any future violations of Sections 22(c) and 31(a) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 22c-1 and 31a-1 thereunder. The Bank consented to the entry of the Order without admitting or denying the Commission's findings.

The Commission found that the Bank, in its capacity as fund accountant, erroneously priced a security for approximately five weeks that was contained in a money market portfolio within The HighMark Group, a registered investment company (Fund). Due to inadequate internal control procedures, the security was priced at over 42% more than its market value. Consequently, the Bank incorrectly computed the Fund's net assets and the Fund sold and redeemed shares at a price other than its correct net asset value per share. As a result, the Bank caused the Fund to violate the pricing and books and records provisions of the Investment Company Act. (Rel. IC-19545 - June 28)
