RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

PUBLICATION OF SALARY OFFSET REGULATION

The Commission has authorized publication of its Salary Offset regulation SECR 15-3. The regulation provides that the Commission may collect, by salary offset against a current or former Commission employee's current pay account, without his or her consent, debts owed to the U.S. Government. The regulation sets for his procedures for the administration of salary offset. The Commission is required by the Debt Collection Act of 1982 to adopt this regulation. ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

RICHARD KURSMAN BARRED

The Commission entered an Order Instituting Public Proceedings Pursuant to Section 15(b)(6) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, Making Findings, and Imposing Remedial Sanctions against Richard T. Kursman, formerly employed as a trader in the high yield department of Merrill Lynch, Pierce, Fenner & Smith, Inc. (Merrill), a broker-dealer registered with the Commission.

The Order contains findings that Kursman was permanently enjoined on September 14, 1992 by the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York. SEC v. Richard T. Kursman and Edward L. Scherer, 92 Civ. 6300, from violating Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act, and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, and aiding and abetting violations of Section 17(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 17a-3 and 17a-4 thereunder. The Commission's complaint filed against Kursman alleged that from in or about September 1990 through September 1991 Kursman, while employed as a trader of high yield securities by Merrill, violated the antifraud provisions of the Exchange Act by causing Merrill to sell high yield securities from Merrill's proprietary account to nominee accounts in which Kursman had financial interests concealed from Merrill, at prices more favorable than would have been offered to certain other Merrill retail customers, and Kursman aided and abetted violations of the recordkeeping rules applicable to registered broker-dealers.

Kursman consented to the issuance of the Order, which bars him from association with any broker, dealer, investment advisor, investment company or municipal securities dealer. (Rel. 34-32585)

RONALD SALDA BARRED

The Commission announced that it has ordered that Ronald Salda (Salda) be permanently barred from association with any broker or dealer. Salda failed to answer the order which instituted administrative proceedings against him on April 12, 1993. Commission found, based on the order instituting the proceedings, that from at least 1984 to in or about August 1986 Salda was a registered representative of brokerdealers registered with the Commission; on December 11, 1987, Salda was barred by the National Association of Securities Dealers (NASD) from further association with any member of the NASD and fined \$80,000 for misuse of a client's funds; and on April 17, 1992, Salda was permanently enjoined by default by a federal district court from further violations and aiding and abetting violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. In the complaint filed in the injunctive action, the Commission alleged that from at least June 1986 to in or about August 1986, Salda participated in a scheme to defraud purchasers of unregistered securities in Calico Corporation (Calico) by, among other things, offering and selling unregistered Calico securities to investors without informing them that the market for Calico was controlled by undisclosed control persons who were engaging in the manipulation of the price of Calico securities. NASD ACTION AGAINST DALE RUSSELL SUSTAINED

The Commission has found that Dale M. Russell of La Verne, California, formerly a salesman with Transamerica Financial Resources, Inc., a member of the NASD, and certain of its affiliates, engaged in private securities transaction without providing Transamerica prior written notification. Russell was censured, fined \$53,287, and suspended from association with any member firm in any capacity for seven days.

In sustaining the NASD, the Commission rejected Russell's argument that he should not be held liable because he had verbally disclosed his plans to engage in these transactions to Transamerica in advance. He further claimed that he attempted -- albeit unsuccessfully -- to delay his starting date with Transamerica until after the transactions had been concluded, and that he was unaware of his association with Transamerica at the time of the transactions.

The Commission found that Russell's efforts towards compliance were "wholly inadequate." Moreover, the Commission noted that "had Russell been successful in delaying his association with Transamerica he could have been selling the securities as an unregistered broker-dealer," which would have constituted a violation of the Securities Exchange Act. Finally, in sustaining the NASD's sanctions, the Commission observed that private securities transactions "represent a potential danger both to a salesman's customers and to his firm." (Rel. 34-32592)

NASD ACTION AGAINST KLAUS LANGHEINRICH REMANDED

The Commission has remanded to the NASD proceedings instituted against Klaus Langheinrich of Murray, Utah. The NASD sanctioned Langheinrich for improperly participating in private securities transactions without giving prior written notice to his employer, P.B. Jameson and Co., Inc.

Langheinrich argued that he gave the required notice of these transactions to his brother, Michael Langheinrich, who held a license as a general securities principal and who was also employed by Jameson. However, the record did not indicate whether Michael Langheinrich was a principal of Jameson or whether he received the required written notice. Finding that an answer to these two questions was essential to resolution of the appeal, the Commission remanded the matter to the NASD. Acting Chairman Schapiro and Commissioner Roberts concurred in the result, and Commissioner Beese dissented. (Rel. 34-32603)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

FORMER OREGON RESIDENT NAMED IN INJUNCTIVE ACTION FOR SALE OF UNREGISTERED SECURITIES AND FRAUD

The Commission announced that on July 9 a complaint was filed in U.S. District Court for the District of Oregon against Theron D. Mitchell, formerly a resident of Gold Hill, Oregon, now residing in Provo, Utah. The complaint alleges that Mitchell violated the registrations and antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, in connection with offering stock in the form of "beneficial interests" in a gold recovery company named, M-3 Hydrotech, Ltd. The complaint alleges that in connection with this offering, which raised more than \$3 million from over 600 investors, Mitchell, among other things, sold unregistered securities, misrepresented to potential investors the amount of gold in the ore M-3 intended to process, misrepresented that M-3 was applying for a patent on the gold removal device it intended to use, misrepresented the amount of money M-3 planned to raise and the number of investors involved, and misappropriated more than \$600,000 from the offering proceeds.

The complaint seeks an injunction, disgorgement and prejudgment interest. [SEC v. Theron D. Mitchell, No. CV 93-824-PA, D.Ore.] (LR-13705)

PARTIAL SUMMARY JUDGMENT GRANTED AGAINST KARL DAHLSTROM

The Commission announced that on July 9 Partial Summary Judgment was granted by the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Texas against Karl L. Dahlstrom (Dahlstrom) and an Order of Permanent Injunction was entered against Dahlstrom enjoining him from future violations of the securities registration and broker-dealer registration provisions of the federal securities laws.

According to the Commission's complaint, filed September 30, 1992, Dahlstrom engaged in a nationwide campaign to sell unregistered shares of Inferno Snuffers, Inc. (ISI) and Inferno Engineering and Consulting, Inc. (IEC), two companies under his control. During the campaign, an excess of \$2 million was raised from over 500 investors in at least 25 states. The complaint alleged that ISI and IEC, operating under Dahlstrom's direction, were purportedly marketing "Uni-Snuff", a product claimed to be useful in extinguishing and suppressing fires, and the "Snuffer System", a method of dispensing Uni-Snuff. CANADA LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY OF NEW YORK, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 6, 1993 to request a hearing on an application filed by Canada Life Insurance Company of New York, Canada Life Insurance Company of New York Variable Annuity Account 2 (Variable Account) and Canada Life of America Financial Services, Inc. for an order that would allow Applicants to deduct a mortality and expense risk charge from the assets of the Variable Account.
