COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

EDGAR PHASE-IN LIST UPDATES

On March 18, 1993, the Commission published in the Federal Register the phase-in list according to which registrants whose filings are processed by the Division of Investment Management are to begin mandatory electronic filing on the Commission's Electronic Data Gathering, Analysis, and Retrieval (EDGAR) system (Rel. IC-19284, February 23, 1993; 58 FR 14848). The Commission has published a cumulative list of updates to the Division of Investment Management phase-in list (Rel. IC-19554, July 1, 1993; 58 FR 37036, July 9, 1993).

A change to a company's phase-in date is of particular significance to persons filing documents with respect to that company, since generally such persons must file electronically when the company becomes subject to electronic filing.

Updates will be published from time to time in the SEC News Digest and copies of the phase-in list updates will be available through the Commission's public reference room. They also will be posted on the EDGAR electronic bulletin board.

In addition, the Division has placed in the public reference room two copies of the phase-in list as of June 28, 1993, one with registrants sorted by phase-in group and investment company complex, and the other with registrants sorted alphabetically by name. ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

THE COMMISSION ISSUES A CEASE AND DESIST ORDER AGAINST CALOGERO CALCAGNO

The Commission announced on July 12 the institution of a cease and desist proceeding pursuant to Section 8A of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Calogero Calcagno, the former Vice President for Operations of General Technologies Group Ltd., a Copaigue, New York manufacturer of electro-mechanical and electro-optical equipment. Simultaneous with the institution of the proceeding, and without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, Calcagno consented to the issuance of an Order Instituting Cease and Desist Proceedings and Findings and Order of the Commission. The Commission's Order finds that Calcagno violated or caused General Tech to violate Section 17(a) of the Securities Act, Sections 10(b), 13(a) and 13(b)(2) of the Exchange Act and Rules 10b-5, 12b-20, 13a-1, 13a-13, 13b2-1 and 13b2-2 promulgated thereunder by assisting General Tech's Chief Executive Officer and a consultant who had substantial responsibility for preparing General Tech's financial statements in implementing a fraudulent scheme to overstate materially General Tech's reported income. The Order finds that Calcagno carried out their directives to falsify inventory reports and to lie to General Tech's auditors (See In the Matter of Calogero Calcagno). JAMES ALLAN BAUER BARRED

The Commission has instituted public administrative proceedings pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) against James Allan Bauer (Bauer). The Commission simultaneously accepted Bauer's Offer of Settlement, in which, without admitting or denying the matters set forth in the Order Instituting Proceedings (Order), Bauer consented to its issuance. The Order permanently bars Bauer from associating with any broker-dealer, investment company, investment adviser or municipal securities dealer. The bar is based upon Bauer's misappropriation of \$356,000 of client funds while employed as a registered representative from February 1990 through May 1992, thereby willfully violating Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The bar is also based upon Bauer's criminal conviction by the State of Kansas of eight felony counts of unlawful acts in connection with the sale or purchase of securities. In connection with Bauer's criminal conviction, Bauer was sentenced to eight to forty years in prison which was suspended to thirty days incarceration, payment of \$361,000 in restitution and court costs, and a minimum of five years probation. NASD PROCEEDINGS AGAINST PATTEN SECURITIES CORP. AND JOHN PATTEN REMANDED

The Commission has remanded to the NASD disciplinary proceedings against Patten Securities Corporation (firm), a Far Hills, New Jersey member firm, and John L. Patten (Patten), its president. The Commission directed the NASD to reassess the sanctions against the firm and Patten on the basis of the violative conduct found by the Commission, to recompute the amount of disgorgement and to refund the monies disgorged to defrauded investors.

In 1986, the firm was the sole underwriter of an offering of 5,750,000 units of Horizon Capital Corp. at 3 cents per unit, all of which was sold to the firm's customers. The Horizon offering closed on January 24, 1986. The NASD found that the firm and Patten manipulated the market for Horizon from early February through March 14, 1986. The Commission agreed that respondents had engaged in a manipulation for part of that period, February 5 through February 19, during which they raised Horizon's price to 7, more than twice the offering price. The Commission found that respondents "deliberately abused their power over market price resulting from their exclusive control of supply ... to cause a sharp and unwarranted rise in the market price of Horizon while keeping excess securities from depressing the market by absorbing them into inventory." It concluded, however, that the evidence was insufficient to find a manipulation after February 19, noting that various positive developments had occurred in Horizon's outlook, and that the firm's sales of Horizon substantially exceeded its purchases during that period.

The NASD based its computation of the amount of disgorgement on the profits realized by certain Patten family accounts on sales of Horizon to the firm. The Commission concluded that these transactions were "essentially an internal reshuffling of assets." It stated that the proper disgorgement figure should represent the total wrongful profit realized by the firm on Horizon trades through March 14, 1986, noting that prices after February 19 may have been affected by the prior manipulation.

Commissioner Beese dissented in part. In his view, "the manipulation extended throughout the period embraced by the NASD's findings of violation, although to a lesser extent." He also considered that the NASD was correct in ordering disgorgement of the Horizon profits earned by Patten family accounts since the sales made by those accounts to the firm "were an integral part of the manipulation." HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MASSACHUSETTS ELECTRIC COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Massachusetts Electric Company (MEC), an electric public-utility subsidiary company of New England Electric System, a registered holding company. MEC proposes to acquire at any time or from time to time through December 31, 1994 all or a portion of certain series of its first mortgage bonds. (Rel. 35-25853)

NEW ENGLAND POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by New England Power Company (NEPCO), an electric public-utility subsidiary company of New England Electric System, a registered holding company. NEPCO proposes to acquire and redeem at any time or from time to time through June 30, 1995 certain series of its cumulative preferred stock. (Rel. 35-25854)

UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the <u>Midwest Stock Exchange</u> for unlisted trading privileges in one over-the-counter issue and an application to withdraw unlisted trading privileges in one over-the-counter issue. (Rel. 34-32636) An order has been issued granting the application of the <u>Pacific Stock Exchange</u> for unlisted trading privileges in one issue which is listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchange and is reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. (Rel. 34-32643)

DELISTING GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the <u>Boston Stock Exchange</u> to strike from listing and registration Bailey Corporation, Common Stock, \$.10 Par Value. (Rel. 34-32642)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-OCC-92-34) filed by <u>The Options</u> <u>Clearing Corporation</u> that permits OCC to operate a centralized facility for administering stock loan and borrow transactions between OCC clearing members and that permits OCC to allow certain stock loan and borrow positions resulting from such transactions to constitute hedges against stock option positions overlying the same stocks for purposes of OCC's margin calculation. (Rel. 34-32638)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-MSRB-93-05) filed by the <u>Municipal</u> <u>Securities Rulemaking Board</u> relating to book-entry delivery of municipal securities for delivery vs. payment or receipt vs. payment customer transactions in depository eligible securities. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of July 19. (Rel. 34-32640)

BEVERAGE GROUP ACQUISITION CORPORATION SEVEN-UP/RC BOTTLING COMPANY OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA, INC.

An order has been issued granting the application of Beverage Group Acquisition Corporation (Beverage Group) and Seven-Up/RC Bottling Company of Southern California, Inc. (Seven-Up) for an exemption for Beverage Group from the reporting requirements of Section 15(d) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended. (Rel. 34-32637)
