RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

RULES 2a19-2 AND 2a3-1 ADOPTED

The Commission has adopted Rules 2a19-2 and 2a3-1 under the Investment Company Act of 1940. Rule 2a19-2 excepts from the definition of interested person in Section 2(a)(19) the general partners that serve as directors of limited partnership investment companies, provided that the partnership agreement contains in substance certain provisions that are set forth in the rule. Rule 2a3-1 excepts from the definition of affiliated person in Section 2(a)(3) those limited partners of limited partnership investment companies that are affiliated persons solely because they are limited partners. COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

SEC NAMES HEAD OF PHILADELPHIA OFFICE

On August 26, Chairman Levitt announced the appointment Donald M. Hoerl to be the head of the Commission's Philadelphia Office.

Mr. Hoerl currently is the Associate Regional Administrator in charge of the Commission's Salt Lake City Branch Office, a position he has held since June 1987. Prior to that time, Mr. Hoerl was the Chief Trial Counsel for the Commission's Denver Regional Office. Mr. Hoerl was an Assistant United States Attorney in Denver Colorado for five years before joining the Commission in 1982. (Press Rel. 93-30)

PERSONNEL REORGANIZATION IN COMMISSION'S REGIONAL OFFICE PROGRAM

Boston and Philadelphia District Offices. In the short term, there will be no change in the Southeast Region; however, planning will begin to designate Miami as the Regional Office responsible for the Atlanta District Office. William McLucas, the Director of Enforcement, will have overall responsibility for these five regional offices but the other Commission Division Directors in the Commission's Washington headquarters will be responsible for managing their respective programs in each office.

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST ROBERT JOHNSTON AND FIDUCIARY PLANNING

The Commission announced that on August 23 a complaint was filed in the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan against Robert Johnston (Johnston), a resident of Birmingham, Michigan, and Fiduciary Planning, Inc. (FPI), an unregistered broker-dealer owned and run by Johnston. The complaint requests that the Court enter an Order of Permanent Injunction and disgorgement against Johnston and FPI based on their violations and/or aiding and abetting violations of the securities registration, broker-dealer registration and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. The complaint alleges that from at least June 1989 through December 1989, Johnston and FPI misrepresented and omitted material facts in connection with their offer and sale of unregistered securities in the form of U.S. and foreign government bonds or investment contracts in Eurobond Exchange Ltd. (Eurobond). Specifically, the complaint alleges that Johnston and FPI failed to adequately investigate the Eurobond investment and materially misrepresented and omitted to state material facts concerning, among other things, the risks and returns of the Eurobond investment and the commissions of up to 12% that they received from their sales of the investment. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

COLONIAL ADVANCED STRATEGIES GOLD TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 20, 1993 to request a hearing on an application filed by Colonial Advanced Strategies Gold Trust for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that applicant has ceased to be an investment company. AMERICAN CAPITAL COMSTOCK FUND, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 20, 1993 to request a hearing on an application filed by the American Capital Comstock Fund, Inc., et al. for an order under Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of the Investment Company Act that would exempt applicants from Sections 12(d) (1), 17(a) (1), and 17(a) (2), and under Section 17(d) and Rule 17d-1 thereunder permitting certain transactions. The order would permit the American Capital Small Capitalization Fund, Inc., an open-end investment company advised by American Capital Asset Management Inc. (American Capital), to serve exclusively as an investment vehicle through which other open-end investment companies advised by American Capital could invest portions of their assets in a portfolio of small capitalization stocks. (Rel. IC-19660 - August 26)

AMERICAN CAPITAL COMSTOCK FUND, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 20, 1993 to request a hearing on an application filed by the American Capital Comstock Fund, Inc., et al. for an order under Section 45(a) of the Investment Company Act. The order would declare that public disclosure of certain information submitted in support of another application filed by applicants and relating to anticipated annual cost savings is neither necessary nor appropriate in the public interest or for the protection of investors. The other application would permit the American Capital Small Capitalization Fund, Inc., an open-end investment company advised by American Capital Asset Management, Inc. (American Capital), to serve as an investment vehicle through which other open-end investment companies advised by American Capital could invest a portion of their assets in a portfolio of small capitalization stocks. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

AMERICAN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY, INC., ET AL.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by American Electric Power Company, Inc. (AEP), a registered holding company, and its nonutility subsidiary company, AEP Investments, Inc. (AEP Investments), whereby AEP will contribute up to \$1 million to the capital of AEP Investments to be used to make up to a \$1 million short-term loan to InterSource Technologies, Inc. (Rel. 35-25871)

LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES SOUGHT

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until September 16, 1993 to comment on the applications of three exchanges for unlisted trading privileges in issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchange and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The <u>Philadelphia Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-Phlx-93-08) to amend Floor Procedure Advice F-2 regarding the time stamping, matching and access to matched trades on the Exchange's equity options and foreign currency options floors. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of August 30. (Rel. 34-32792)

The <u>American Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-Amex-92-26) to amend Rule 170 to establish a one year pilot program for specialists' liquidating transactions. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of August 30. (Rel. 34-32804)

AMENDMENT FILED AND PARTIAL APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>New York Stock Exchange</u> filed an amendment to a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-93-04) to permit the Exchange to trade options that expire on the second business day following the end of each calendar quarter based on the NYSE Utility Index. In addition, the Commission has approved the NYSE's proposal to enable the Exchange to list and trade options on the NYSE Composite Stock Index that expire on the second business day following the end of each calendar quarter. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of August 30. (Rel. 34-32793)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-MSRB-93-10) relating to technical amendments to Rules G-27 and G-29. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of August 30. (Rel. 34-32803)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-92-51) to amend Part I, Section 1 and Part II, Sections 8 and 9 of the NASD Code of Arbitration Procedure. The proposed rule would require that any dispute, claim, or controversy arising out of the employment or termination of employment of an associated person by and with an NASD member shall be arbitrated. (Rel. 34-32802)
