## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

### EDGAR PHASE-IN LIST UPDATES AVAILABLE TO PUBLIC

Pursuant to Rule 901 of Regulation S-T, registrants whose filings are processed by the Division of Corporation Finance may request a change in the date they become subject to mandated electronic filing on the Electronic Data Gathering, Analysis, and Retrieval ("EDGAR") system. The Division intends to publish from time to time changes and corrections to the phase-in list published in the Federal Register on March 18, 1993 (Release No. 33-6977, February 23, 1993, 58 FR 14628). A change to a company's phase-in date is of particular importance to persons or entities filing documents with respect to that company, since generally such persons must file electronically when the company becomes subject to electronic filing.

The updates will be published in the SEC News Digest and copies of the phase-in list updates will be available through the Commission's public reference room. They also will be posted on the EDGAR electronic bulletin board.

In addition, the Division has placed in the public reference room a copy of the phase-in list as of February 23, 1993, with companies sorted by group number. This information was published in the Federal Register on March 18, 1993, with all companies being listed in alphabetical order rather than sorted by group number. 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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### HAROLD RAPHAEL

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) against Harold Raphael (Raphael), formerly a registered representative of American Capital Equities, Inc., a broker-dealer registered with the Commission. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Raphael's Offer of Settlement (Offer) in which he agreed, without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, to entry of an Order barring him from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company. In that Order, the Commission found that during the period between August 10, 1987 and on or about December 31, 1987, Raphael willfully violated the registration and anti-fraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act) and the Exchange Act by, among other things, failing to disclose that he and registered representatives under his control were paid undisclosed commissions by persons controlling the issuers of the securities. The Commission also found that a final judgment of permanent injunction was entered against Raphael for violating the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act and the Exchange Act (SEC v. Pak-Man et al., Case No. 91-6744-CIV-MOORE, S.D. Fla.). (Rel. 34-32782)

### MARK BRECHER

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) against Mark Brecher (Brecher), formerly a registered representative of American Capital Equities, Inc., a broker-dealer registered with the Commission. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Brecher's Offer of Settlement (Offer) in which he agreed, without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, to entry of an Order barring him from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company.

In the Order, the Commission found that during the period between January 1, 1987 and on or about October 15, 1987, Brecher willfully violated the registration and anti-fraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act) and the Exchange Act by, among other things, falsely stating to investors that their securities would double in value within a year. The Commission also found that a final judgment of permanent injunction was entered against Brecher for violating the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act and the Exchange Act (SEC v. Pak-Man et al., Case No. 91-6744-CIV-MOORE, S.D. Fla.). (Rel. 34-32783)

## COMMISSION IMPOSES SANCTIONS AGAINST CHARLES FERGUSON

The Commission announced that it issued an Order Instituting Proceedings, Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions in public administrative proceedings instituted pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) against Charles Ferguson (Ferguson), at various times the vice president of operations and financial consultant for Zenox, Inc. The Commission accepted an Offer of Settlement from Ferguson in which he consented to be barred from participating in any offering of penny stock. The Commission imposed this sanction and made its findings based on the entry of a final judgment of permanent injunction that was issued against Ferguson on July 22, 1993, by the United States District Court for the Northern District of Georgia enjoining him from violating the antifraud provisions of the Exchange Act and aiding and abetting violations of the books and records and reporting provisions of the Exchange Act. ## COMMISSION SANCTIONS CHARLES FERGUSON, CPA

The Commission announced that it issued an Order Instituting Proceedings, Opinion and Order Pursuant to Rule 2(e) of the Commission's Rules of Practice against Charles Ferguson (Ferguson), a certified public accountant practicing in Atlanta, Georgia. At various times between 1989 and 1992, Ferguson was the vice president of operations and/or financial consultant for Zenox, Inc., a penny stock company formerly headquartered in Atlanta, Georgia. The Commission accepted an Offer of Settlement from Ferguson in which he consented to being permanently denied the privilege of appearing or practicing before the Commission. The Commission imposed this sanction and based its Opinion upon the entry of a final judgment of permanent injunction that was issued against Ferguson on July 22, 1993, by the United States District Court for the Northern District of Georgia enjoining him from violating the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and from aiding abetting violations of the books and records and reporting provisions of the Exchange Act. 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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST H.I. GLASS & COMPANY

The Commission announced that on July 21 the United States District Court in Cleveland, Ohio entered an Order of Permanent Injunction against H.I. Glass & Company (Glass & Co.). Glass & Co. consented to the entry of the injunction without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's complaint. In that complaint, the Commission alleged that Glass & Co., a registered investment adviser, and Herbert I. Glass (Glass), its sole owner and control person, violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933, the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and the Investment Advisers Act, and violated certain books and records and filing requirements of the Advisers Act.

The Commission alleged, among other things, that between 1986 and 1989, Glass & Co. and Glass sold securities in the form of investment partnership interests and, in connection therewith, reimbursed Glass & Co. up to approximately \$200,000 from investor funds for expenses not related to the operation of the partnerships. The Commission further alleged that Glass & Co., through Glass, improperly entered into

a performance fee agreement, and, between 1986 and 1988, may have received up to approximately \$1.5 million in illegal performance fees. [SEC v. Herbert I. Glass and H.I. Glass & Company, N.D. Ohio, Civil Action No. 1:93 CV 959] (LR-13767)
