PENNY STOCK DEFINITION FOR PURPOSES OF THE BLANK CHECK RULE

The Commission has published a release announcing the adoption of a previously proposed revision to the "penny stock" definition for purposes of its rules relating to the registration statements filed by blank check companies under the Securities Act of 1933. The revision makes the exclusion from the penny stock definition for securities priced at five dollars or more inapplicable to securities offerings subject to Section 7(b) of the Securities Act and Rule 419 thereunder. The revision is effective upon publication in the Federal Register and applies to new as well as registration statements currently pending but not yet effective with the Commission. COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

JIMON LORNE NAMED GENERAL COUNSEL

Chairman Levitt today announced the appointment of Simon M. Lorne as General Counsel.

Since 1972, Mr. Lorne has been a partner in the Los Angeles law firm of Munger, Tolles & Olson, practicing primarily in the areas of securities and corporate law. He is the author of Acquisitions and Mergers: Negotiated and Contested Transactions, as well as numerous articles and two monographs. He is an active member of the American Bar Association's Section of Business Law and is a frequent panelist and lecturer. In addition, Mr. Lorne has taught securities law at the University of Pennsylvania and University of South California Law Schools. Mr. Lorne is a 1967 Phi Beta Kappa graduate of Occidental College. He was awarded his J.D. degree, magna cum laude, by the University of Michigan Law School in 1970. (Press Rel. 93-46)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PERMANENT INJUNCTION ISSUED AGAINST 1ST AMERICAN CORPORATION, JOHN WOODS AND OTHERS

The Commission announced that on October 7 the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania entered an order permanently enjoining 1st American Corporation, John Robert Woods, G. Woods Mortgages and Approved Mortgage Corporation, all of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. The court's order followed a two-day contempt proceeding in which the Commission claimed that the defendants violated a May 27, 1993 preliminary injunction by commencing a subsequent fraudulent offering.

The court found that the defendants made material misrepresentations and omissions in connection with an initial offer and sale of purported collateralized mortgage obligations or "CMOs." The defendants mischaracterized the attributes and safeguards associated with their CMOs, particularly by suggesting that the product carried an implied AAA rating, when it did not. The court further found that the defendants' subsequent offering of securities violated the preliminary injunction because the related sales literature also contained false and misleading statements. The court concluded by deferring a ruling on a finding of civil contempt to observe whether or not the defendants comply with the court's October 7, 1993 order. The court must still decide the appropriateness of a civil penalty and the issue of restitution. [SEC v. 1st American Corporation, et. al., W.D. Pa. Civ. No. 93-0561] (LR-13846)

COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST WILLIAM AND CARLA RUEFF

The Commission announced that on October 25 it filed a complaint in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of California against Carla D. Rueff, a former employee of Cray Computer Corporation (Cray Computer), and her husband, William A. Rueff, both residents of Pleasanton, California. The complaint alleges that the Rueffs violated Sections 17(a)(1), (2) and (3) of the Securities Act of 1933, Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder when they sold 4000 shares of Cray Computer common stock on December 23, 1991 while in possession of material non-public information concerning the assignment of a significant supercomputer contract to another company. The Commission is seeking an injunction against the Rueffs, disgorgement of losses avoided totalling \$20,672 and prejudgment interest and penalties thereon. [SEC v. Carla D. and William A. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ALLIED CAPITAL CORPORATION, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 16, 1993 to request a hearing on an application filed by Allied Capital Corporation, et al. under Sections 17(d) and 57(a)(4) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 17d-1 thereunder. The order would permit Allied Capital Corporation and Allied Capital Lending Corporation to make joint public offerings of shares of Allied Capital Lending Corporation. (Rel. IC-19810 - October 22)

KLEINWORT BENSON INVESTMENT STRATEGIES

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 16, 1993 to request a hearing on an application filed by Kleinwort Benson Investment Strategies for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. ARK FUNDS, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 16, 1993 to request a hearing on an application filed by Ark Funds, et al. for a conditional order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act. The order would exempt applicants from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 18(f)(1), 18(g), 18(i), 22(c), and 22(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder. The order would permit applicants to issue and sell an unlimited number of classes of shares representing interests in the same portfolio of securities, and to assess and, under certain circumstances, waive a contingent deferred sales charge on redemptions of certain shares. JOHN HARVEY EARLY

A notice of and order for hearing has been issued, pursuant to Section 211(c) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940, on an application by John Harvey Early, a registered investment adviser. The application seeks an order under Section 206A of the Advisers Act granting an exemption from Section 205(a)(1) thereof to permit the use of a performance fee arrangement. The notice of and order for hearing gives any person other than the parties who wishes to be heard or otherwise participate in the proceeding until November 24, 1993 to seek leave to do so by filing an application with the Secretary of the Commission, as provided by Rule 9(c) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, that sets forth the nature and extent of the applicant's interest in the proceeding. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NEW ENGLAND ENERGY INCORPORATED

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 15, 1993 to request a hearing on a proposal by New England Energy Incorporated, a fuel supply subsidiary of New England Electric System, a registered holding company, to extend its existing authority, through December 31, 1995, to enter into interest rate protection agreements in respect to up to \$200 million in principal amount of its outstanding debt. CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORP.

A supplemental notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 15, 1993 to request a hearing on a proposal by Central and South West Corporation, a registered holding company, to extend existing authority granted by order dated December 23, 1991 (HCAR No. 25440) to repurchase up to 17,426,440 shares (or such equivalent number of shares as may result from any combination of split shares) through December 31, 1995. CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 15, 1993 to request a hearing on a proposal by Central and South West Corporation (CSW), a registered holding company. CSW requests an extension of previously granted authority, through December 31, 1994, to purchase up to \$500 million aggregate principal amount of CSW common stock. The common stock would be placed in a leveraged employee stock ownership plan (LESOP), which is part of CSW's Employees' Thrift Plan. CSW also requests an extension of previously granted authority, through December 31, 1994, for the LESOP trust to finance the acquisition of CSW's common stock through the issuance of notes in an amount not to exceed \$500 million, to CSW or to institutional lenders, which CSW proposes to guarantee. Further, CSW requests an extension of previously granted authority, through December 31, 1994, providing that loans to the LESOP trust from CSW would be financed by CSW through the issuance and sale of commercial paper, medium term notes or notes to institutional lenders in the amount of \$500 million. PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

ACQUISITION OF SECURITIES

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.

Below is a list of recent filings of Schedules 13D and 14D, which includes the following information: Column 1 - the company purchased (top), and the name of the purchaser; Column 2 - the type of security purchased; Column - 3 - the type of form filed; Column 4 - the date the transaction occurred; Column 5 - the current number of shares (in 000's) owned (top) and the current percent owned; Column 6 - the CUSIP number (top) and the percent owned; and Column 7 - the status of the filing, i.e., new, update or revision.
