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COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

U.S. SECURITIES EXCHANGE COMMISSION.

GARY SUNDICK APPOINTED ASSOCIATE DIRECTOR

Chairman Levitt announced today the appointment of Gary N. Sundick to the position of Associate Director, Division of Enforcement. Mr. Sundick will oversee several groups responsible for the conduct of enforcement investigations and will also be in charge of operations of the Division of Enforcement's Office of Market Surveillance. SUSAN BAUMANN APPOINTED DEPUTY EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Chairman Levitt announced today the appointment of Susan Baumann as the Deputy Executive Director of the Commission. The Office of the Executive Director oversees all of the agency's management and administrative operations. These activities include personnel, procurement and space management; budget and financial operations; document receipt and processing, and consumer affairs; and information technology. INCREASE IN COPYING FEES

Effective December 1, 1993, the copying fee goes up from \$0.22 to \$0.24 per page for Commission records made available to the public through the Public Reference rooms and under the Freedom of Information Act. This increase is in conformity with the Commission's dissemination contract, which provides for a periodic adjustment of fees for copying such records.

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

DEMARCHE ASSOCIATES, INC. AND ROBERT MARCHESI SANCTIONED

The Commission announced the entry of an Order Instituting Public Administrative Proceedings Pursuant to Sections 203(e), (f), (i) and (k) of the Investment Advisers Act (IAA), Making Findings and Order to Cease and Desist against DeMarche Associates, Inc. (DAI), a registered investment adviser located in Westwood, Kansas, and its president, Robert F. Marchesi (Marchesi). The Order charges DAI with primary violations and Marchesi with aiding and abetting DAI's violations of Section 15(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Sections 204, 206(4) and 207 of the IAA and Rules 204-1(b) and 206(4)-2 thereunder based upon DAI's failure to disclose that it receives between 15% and 20% more revenue for the same services when paid in soft dollars rather than in cash, its failure to properly account for client funds in custody, and its failure to register with the Commission as a broker-dealer for its "program sales" service. These violations were discovered during a routine examination of DAI in June 1991.

DAI and Marchesi both consented to the Order without admitting or denying any of the violations set forth therein. DAI agreed to cease and desist from committing or causing any violation or future violations of these provisions of the federal securities laws; to register with the Commission as a broker-dealer and conduct an audit of client funds held in custody; and to pay a civil penalty of \$25,000. Marchesi agreed to pay a civil penalty of \$5,000. (Rel. IA-1392)

SIX FORMER FIRST ALLIANCE ASSOCIATES INDICTED

The Commission, the U.S. Attorney for the Northern District of Georgia, and the Georgia Secretary of State announced the indictment of William F. Lincoln (Lincoln), Calvin L. Word (Word), Thomas J. Word (T. Word), Daniel C. Baxley (Baxley), Richard A. Anders (Anders) and Dawn Dailey (Dailey) before G. Ernest Tidwell, United States District Judge for the Northern District of Georgia, on November 22, 1993. The grand jury returned a forty-eight count indictment charging securities fraud, wire fraud, interstate transportation of monies taken by fraud, and conspiracy. At the time of the conduct charged in the indictment, T. Word, Baxley, Anders and Dailey were associated as account representatives with First Alliance Securities, Inc. (First Alliance), formerly an Atlanta based registered broker-dealer specializing in penny stocks. Lincoln and Word were the firm's president and vice president, respectively.

The indictment includes allegations that from about February 1989 until about December 1989 the firm and the above-named defendants, among others, generated approximately \$1.4 million in illegal profits by charging First Alliance customers undisclosed, excessive markups and commissions. The indictment also charges that the defendants and other First Alliance representatives, some of whom were not registered with the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc., made or caused to be made misrepresentations and omissions concerning, among other things, the liquidity, suitability and profitability of penny stocks in which First Alliance purported to

make a market, the arbitrary setting of prices of those stocks, and the fact that the defendants had undisclosed interests in such stocks, buying and selling at prices unavailable to ordinary First Alliance investors. Further, the indictment charges that First Alliance and the defendants engaged in fraudulent sales practices, including the use of high-pressure telephone sales techniques, the promotion of certain stocks on certain days to create the appearance of demand, and unauthorized trading in customer accounts.

Six other defendants have pled guilty this year to similar charges in connection with the First Alliance investigation. [U.S. v. William F. Lincoln, et al., Criminal Case No. 1:93-CR-506, ND GA] (LR-13888)

ACTION FILED AGAINST JOHN GAINES and J.M. GAINES & ASSOCIATES, INC.

The Commission announced the filing of a Complaint for Civil Injunction and Other Equitable Relief on November 24 in U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Texas against John Martin Gaines (Gaines) and J.M. Gaines & Associates, Inc. (Gaines & Associates).

The complaint alleged that the defendants violated the broker-dealer registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws in connection with the offer, purchase and sale of securities. According to the complaint, the defendants raised at least \$2.6 million from investors for the purpose of purchasing securities on the investors' behalf; however, contrary to his representations, Gaines converted the investor funds for his own use, and to repay prior investors.

Also on November 24, Judge Robert B. Maloney entered orders permanently enjoining the defendants from future violations of the aforementioned provisions of the securities laws, ordering disgorgement and civil penalties in amounts to be determined, appointing a receiver and freezing the assets of the defendants. The defendants consented to the entry of the orders without admitting or denying the allegations contained in the Commission's complaint. [SEC v. John Martin Gaines and J.M. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

KEYSTONE CUSTODIAN FUND, SERIES B-1, ET AL.

A conditional order has been issued under Section 17(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 17d-1 thereunder to permit Keystone Custodian Fund, Series B-1, et al. to deposit their uninvested cash balances into a joint trading account through which the cash would be invested in repurchase agreements. (Rel. IC-19908 - November 29)

PMC CAPITAL, INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by PMC Capital, Inc., et al., amending an existing order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act. The existing order exempts PMC, and certain subsidiaries of PMC licensed by the Small Business Administration (SBA subsidiaries), from, inter alia, Sections 8(b) and 30(d)

of the Act, and Rules 8b-16 and 30d-1 thereunder, permitting them to file amendments to their registration statements and to transmit reports to their shareholders on a consolidated basis, in lieu of the separate obligations of each of the applicants. The existing order was conditioned on PMC investing no more than 10% of its total assets, calculated on a consolidated basis, in securities other than those of the SBA subsidiaries. The order, as amended, permits PMC to invest more than 10% of its total assets, calculated on a consolidated basis, in securities other than those in which the SBA subsidiaries invest, while continuing to report on a consolidated basis. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES AND WITHDRAWAL GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the <u>Chicago Stock Exchange</u> for unlisted trading privileges in 3 over-the-counter issues, and an application to withdraw unlisted trading privileges in 3 over-the-counter issues. (Rel. 34-33251)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>National Securities Clearing Corporation</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-NSCC-93-13) relating to buy-ins. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of November 29. (Rel. 34-33248)

ACQUISITIONS OF SECURITIES

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
