DELEGATED AUTHORITY

In compliance with Commission Regulation 10.107, the Commission gave the parties an opportunity to be heard with respect to a notice of a proposed procedure contained in its March 25, 2005 Opinion and Order. Any response was to be filed within 15 days of the date of that Order.

On April 11, 2005, respondent Shahrokh Nikkhah filed a motion to extend the comment period 30 days until May 9, 2005, noting that he did not receive the Commission's order until April 6, 2005 and needed time to "study" it. Nikkhah's counsel has had ample time to consider the Commission's proposal. Accordingly, Nikkhah's comments are due April 29, 2005.
