
ORDER

On August 26, 2005 the Commission issued a subpoena *duces tecum*, ordering respondent Shahrokh Nikkhah ("Nikkhah") to produce certain documents relating to his net worth by September 26, 2005. On September 24, 2005, Nikkhah filed a motion to stay compliance with the subpoena, informing the Commission that he has forwarded a check to the Division of Enforcement ("Division") for \$200,000, the full amount of the proposed civil monetary penalty. He requests a stay of production pending the anticipated termination of this proceeding. The Division does not object.

For good cause shown, production of documents pursuant to the subpoena *duces tecum* is stayed.
