COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

SHAD TO OFFICIATE AT SWEARING-IN

Chairman Shad will officiate at the swearing-in of Kathleen A. Warwick as Regional Administrator of the Commission's New York Office on Friday, January 9 at 10:00 a.m. Miss Warwick will be sworn in at the New York Regional Office, 26 Federal Plaza, New York, New York.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

STAY ORDER ISSUED RE BLINDER ROBINSON & CO.

The Commission today issued a stay order in the matter of Blinder, Robinson & Co., Inc. This registrant had appealed an order by the Commission suspending Blinder Robinson for 45 days, prohibiting it from participating in any securities offering following his suspension, and barring Meyer Blinder (president and majority shareholder) from association with any broker or dealer (with the proviso that after two years he may apply to become associated). The Commission stayed its order with respect to the broker-dealer but denied the request with respect to Meyer Blinder.

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

HARWYN INDUSTRIES CORPORATION ENJOINED

The Commission announced that on December 31, 1986 the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Harwyn Industries Corporation of New York, New York. The Judgment required Harwyn to file its delinquent Annual and Quarterly Reports and restrained and enjoined it from failing to file timely and in proper form accurate and complete periodic reports and Notifications of Late Filing in the future.

In its September 23, 1986 complaint, the Commission alleged that Harwyn, as part of a continuing course of violative conduct extending over several years, failed to file its Annual Report on Form 10-K for its fiscal year ended December 31, 1985 and its Quarterly Report on Form 10-Q for its fiscal quarters ended March 31 and June 30, 1986, and failed to file Notifications of Late Filing. Harwyn, consenting to the Court's Judgment, admitted that it had failed to file or filed late three Annual and four Quarterly Reports and a Notification of Late Filing. (SEC v. Harwyn Industries Corporation, USDC DC, Civil Action No. 86-2625). (LR-11324)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

SEARS EQUITY INVESTMENT TRUST, UTILITY STOCK SERIES I

An order has been issued exempting the Sears Equity Investment Trust, Utility Stock Series I, subsequent series of the Utility Stock Trust and similar series of the Sears Equity Investment Trust, and Dean Witter Reynolds Inc. from Sections 14(a) and 19(b) and Rule 19b-1 and granting confidential treatment to Dean Witter's profit and loss statements. (Rel. IC-15501 - Dec. 24, 1986)

WICKLOW 1986 FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 16 to request a hearing on an application filed by Wicklow 1986 Fund requesting an order exempting it from all provisions of the Investment Company Act or, alternatively, from certain provisions thereof in connection with its operation as an employees' securities company. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GENERAL PUBLIC UTILITIES CORPORATION

An order has been issued authorizing General Public Utilities Corporation, a registered holding company, to acquire 7,866 shares of common stock of Exel Limited, a Cayman Islands corporation, for a purchase price of \$150 per share, or an aggregate purchase price of \$1,180,000, in order to obtain liability insurance from XL Insurance Company, Ltd., subsidiary of Exel and a Barbados insurance company organized to underwrite general liability and directors' and officers' liability insurance coverage. COLUMBIA GAS TRANSMISSION CORPORATION

A supplemental order has been issued regarding The Columbia Gas System, Inc., a registered holding company, and its subsidiary, Columbia Gas Transmission Corporation, authorizing intrasystem financing by the subsidiary. (Rel. 35-24279 - Dec. 24, 1986)

CONNECTICUT YANKEE ATOMIC POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Connecticut Yankee Atomic Power Company, subsidiary of Northeast Utilities and New England Electric System, to enter into a Remarketable Credit and Letter of Credit Agreement with a syndicate of foreign banks. The Agreement establishes a revolving credit facility and a letter of credit facility to guarantee the repayment of commercial paper to be issued and sold by Connecticut Yankee. The aggregate principal amount of loans and letters of credit under the Agreement will not exceed \$90 million at any onetime outstanding. The proposed issuance and sale of commercial paper is excepted from the competitive bidding requirements of Rule 50, under Rule 50(a)(5). (Rel. 35-24280 - Dec. 24, 1986)

PENNZOIL COMPANY

An order has been issued declaring Pennzoil Products Company, subsidiary of Pennzoil Company, not to be a gas utility company for purposes of the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935. (Rel. 35-24281 - Dec. 24, 1986)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-86-27) to facilitate prompt payment by members, participants, and their broker-dealer organizations of dues, users' fees, fines, and other Exchange-imposed charges. (Rel. 34-23939)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

AMERICAN EXPRESS CREDIT CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 26 to request a hearing on an application by American Express Credit Corporation under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939. The application declares that the trusteeship of J. Henry Schroder Bank & Trust Company under two existing indentures is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary in the public interest or for the protection of investors to disqualify Schroder from acting as trustee under either indenture.
