An order has been issued to Ohio National Life Assurance Corporation, et al., granting exemptions from Sections 2(a)(32), 22(c), 27(c)(1) and 27(d) of the Act, and from Rule 6e-3(T)(b)(12), (b)(13), (c)(2) and (c)(4), and Rule 22c-1 to issue flexible premium variable life insurance contracts, as defined in paragraph (c)(1) of Rule 6e-3(T), which provide for the waiver of future premiums upon disability of the insured and for a contingent deferred administrative expense charge.
