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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### INJUNCTION ENTERED IN STOCK MANIPULATION SCHEME

The Seattle Regional Office announced that on January 26 a final judgment of permanent injunction by consent was entered against Patrick W.M. Imeson, Patrick W.M. Imeson, doing business as Resource Equity, and Courtney Resources for violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws and credit provisions of Regulation X. The Commission's complaint alleged that defendants made an unregistered distribution of Invermay Resources, Inc. stock, manipulated the market for Invermay stock, and failed to pay for approximately \$1 million in Invermay trades, causing losses to U.S. brokerage firms of at least \$550,000. 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### THOMSON MCKINNON MORTGAGE ASSETS CORPORATION

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### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Intermountain Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-ISE-86-1) to withdraw its current body of rules permitting it to operate as a national securities exchange, maintaining only those rules necessary to preserve its status as a Utah not-for-profit corporation.
